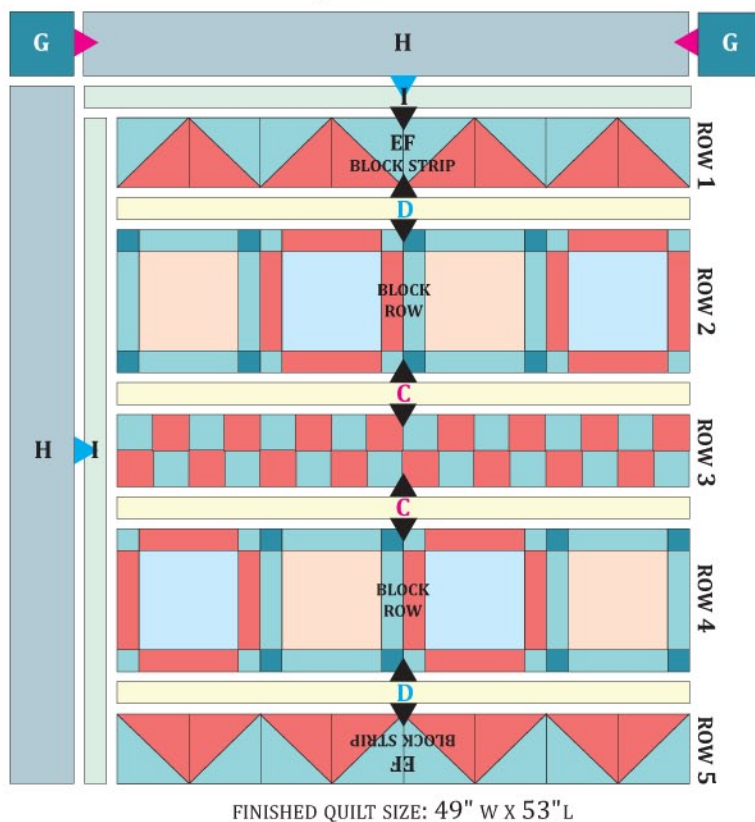

	<b>A</b> Darling Kittens 3630-55 Blue	1/2 YD	(4) FUSSY CUT 6" squares.
	<b>B</b> Darling Kittens 3630-01 Pink	1/2 YD	(4) FUSSY CUT 6" squares.
	<b>C</b> Kitty Stripe 3633-01 Pink	1/4 YD	(2) 2-1/2" x 36-1/2" strips.
	<b>D</b> Kitty Stripe 3633-55 Blue	1/4 YD	(2) 2-1/2" x 36-1/2" strips.
	<b>E</b> Mini Mice 3635-84 Aqua	2/3 YD	(4) 2-1/4" x WOF strips. Subcut (16) 2-1/4" x 6" rectangles. (16) 2-1/4" squares. (8) 5-1/2" squares. (2) 2-3/4" x WOF strips.
	<b>F</b> Mini Mice 3635-10 Dark Pink	2/3 YD	(2) 2-3/4" x WOF strips. (3) 2-1/4" x WOF strips. Subcut (16) 2-1/4" x 6" rectangles. (8) 5-1/2" squares.
	<b>G</b> Mini Mice 3635-59 Turquoise	2/3 YD	(16) 2-1/4" squares. (4) 5" squares. (6) 2-1/2" x WOF strips; BINDING.
	<b>H</b> Linen Texture 988-52 Blue	3/4 YD	(5) 5" x WOF strips, for outer border.
	<b>I</b> Mini Butterflies 3634-55 Blue	1/3 YD	(4) 2-1/2" x WOF strips, for inner border.

WOF=WIDTH OF FABRIC

QUILT DIAGRAM



**FINISHING** Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Place backing, batting and top together in layers and baste or pin. Machine quilt as desired. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind in the usual manner.

## BLOCK ASSEMBLY

**1. HALF SQUARE TRIANGLE BLOCKS:** Place right sides together (1) **E** and **F** 5-1/2" squares, with **F** on top. Draw a diagonal line on wrong side of **F** square and sew 1/4" seam on both sides of drawn line. Cut on drawn line (1a.). Press open the two HALF SQUARE TRIANGLE BLOCKS towards **F** fabric. Square blocks to 5". Make 16 **EF** blocks (1b.).

**2. 4 PATCH STRIP:** Sew (1) **E** and **F** 2-3/4" x WOF strips together along long edge. Press open with seam allowance towards the **E** fabric (2a.). Make 2 **EF** strips. Subcut **EF** strips into (16) 2-3/4" x 5" rectangles (2b.). Sew **EF** rectangles together in a checker board pattern (2c.).

**3. BLOCK ONE:** Sew (1) **E** 2-1/4" x 6" rectangle to each side of (1) **B** 6" square. Set aside. Next add (1) **G** 2-1/4" square to each end of (1) **E** 2-1/4" x 6" rectangle. Make 8 **EG** units. Sew (1) **EG** unit to top and bottom of **EB** unit. Square block to 9-1/2". Make 4.

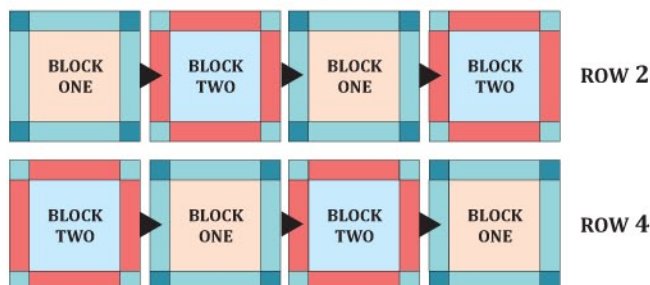
**4. BLOCK TWO:** Repeat step 3 using **E** 2-1/4" squares, **F** 2-1/4" x 6" rectangles and **A** 6" squares. Make 4 BLOCK TWOS.

**QUILT ASSEMBLY** Quilt has 5 rows and 4 sashing strips.

**5. ROWS 1 AND 5:** Sew together (8) **EF** HALF SQUARE TRIANGLE BLOCKS, from step 1. Note proper placement of blocks.



**6. ROWS 2 AND 4:** Sew BLOCKS ONE and TWO together in rows of 4, alternating them. Note proper placement of blocks.



**7.** Referring to *QUILT DIAGRAM* sew together Rows 1-5 with **C** and **D** 2-1/2" x 36-1/2" strips in between.

**BORDERS** Measure width and length of quilt top to ensure cut sizes of **H** and **I** border strips. *\*We've included our measurements in the instructions below.* Refer to *QUILT DIAGRAM*.

**8.** Cut (2) **I** 2-1/2" x (\*40") strips to fit, and sew to each side of quilt top. Then cut (2) **I** 2-1/2" x (\*40-1/2") strips to fit, and sew onto top and bottom of quilt top.

**9.** Sew (3) **H** 5" x WOF strips together via short ends. Subcut strip into (2) 5" x (\*44") strips to fit, and sew to each side of quilt top. Cut (2) **H** 5" x (\*40-1/2") strips and add (1) **G** 5" block to each end of **H** strips. Make 2 **GHG** units. Sew **GHG** borders to top and bottom of quilt top.
