

## TABLE RUNNER DIAGRAM




**BLOCK ASSEMBLY** *Use* 1/4" seam allowance throughout, unless otherwise indicated. Sew QSTs right sides together, matching raw edges.



1. CE/CG BLOCKS: Take (3) C and (1) E 3-1/4" QSTs and sew into a square, (1a.). Square CE BLOCK to 2-1/2. Make 12 CE blocks and 12 CG BLOCKS (1b.).



**2. BLOCK UNIT:** Follow diagram below to make block unit. Square BLOCK UNIT to 10-1/2". Make 3 BLOCK UNITS.



## TABLE RUNNER ASSEEMBLY

- **3.** Referring to QUILT DIAGRAM, sew (4)  $\mathbf{F}$  1-1/4" x 10-1/2" strips to top and bottom of BLOCK UNITS. Set aside.
- **4. CF SASHING STRIP:** Take (3) **F** 1-1/4" x 10-1/2" strips and (4) **C** 1-1/4" squares and sew together, see *QUILT DIAGRAM*. Make 2 **CF** SASHING STRIPS and sew one to each side of table runner.

## BORDER ASSEEMBLY

- **5. Border One:** Sew (1) **A** 1-1/2" x 33-1/2" strip to each side of table runner. Then sew (1) **A** 1-1/2" x 14" strip to top and bottom of table runner.
- **6. Border Two:** Sew (1) **B** 2-1/2" x 14" strip to top and bottom of table runner. Then sew (1) **B** 2-1/2" x 39-1/2" strip to each side of table runner.

**FINISHING** Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind as usual.

FINISHED SIZE: 17-1/2" x 39".
