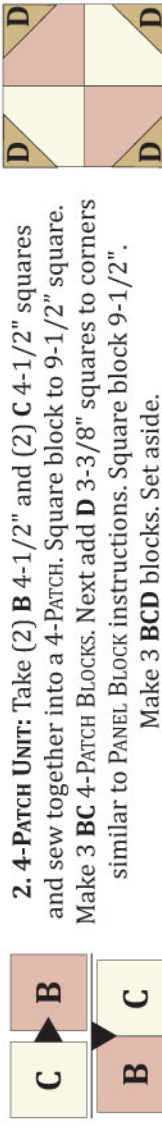
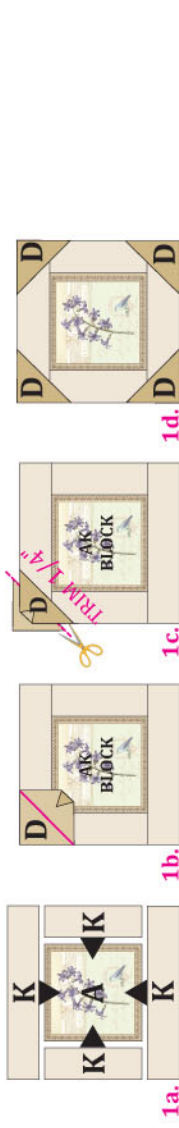
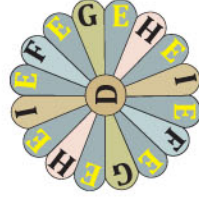


BLOCK ASSEMBLY Use 1/4" seam allowance throughout, unless otherwise indicated. Sew pieces with right sides together, matching raw edges.

1. PANEL BLOCK: Sew (1) **K** 2" x 6-1/2" strip to each side of (1) **A** 6-1/2" square. Then sew (1) **K** 2" x 9-1/2" strip to top and bottom of **AK** unit (1a). Next take (1) **D** 3-3/8" square and draw a diagonal line on wrong side. Place **D** square on upper left hand corner of **AK** BLOCK, right sides together. Sew on diagonal line (1b). Flip **D** lower right hand corner up to **AK** BLOCK upper left hand corner. Press. Trim excess fabric on reverse side to 1/4" (1c). Repeat steps for the remaining (3) corners to complete block. Square **AK** PANEL BLOCK to 9-1/2" (1d). Make 2 **AK** BLOCK PANELS.



2. 4-PATCH UNIT: Take (2) **B** 4-1/2" and (2) **C** 4-1/2" squares and sew together into a 4-PATCH. Square block to 9-1/2" square. Make 3 **BC** 4-PATCH BLOCKS. Next add **D** 3-3/8" squares to corners similar to **PANEL** BLOCK instructions. Square block 9-1/2". Make 3 **BCD** blocks. Set aside.



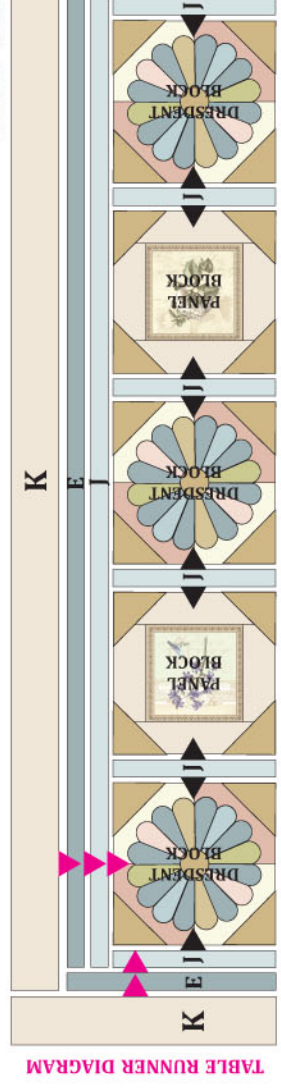
3. DRESDEN CIRCLE: Sew **D-I** DRESDEN PETALS together as shown in diagram. Make 3 DRESDEN CIRCLES. Using your favorite method, appliqué (1) **D** circle to the center of each DRESDEN CIRCLE as shown in diagram. Then appliqué DRESDEN CIRCLES to center of 4-PATCH BLOCKS. Note: DRESDEN TEMPLATE includes 1/4" seam allowance for the "turning under" applique method. If using fusible method, the sewn DRESDEN unit will need to be trimmed to the finished size before fusing.

TABLE RUNNER ASSEMBLY

4. Take (6) **J** 1-1/2" x 9-1/2" strips and sew to top and bottom of **PANEL** and **DRESDEN** BLOCKS, as shown in **TABLE RUNNER DIAGRAM** below.

BORDER ASSEMBLY

5. **Border J:** Sew (1) **J** 1-1/2" x 51-1/2" strip to each side of table runner.
 6. **Border E:** Sew (1) **E** 1-1/2" x 51-1/2" strip to each side of table runner. Then sew (1) **E** 1-1/2" x 13-1/2" strip to top and bottom.
 7. **Border K:** Sew (1) **K** 3-1/2" x 53-1/2" strip to each side of table runner. Then sew (1) **K** 3-1/2" x 19-1/2" strip to top and bottom.

	E Foulard 4118-55 Blue	1/2 YD	(2) 1-1/2" x 13-1/2" strips. (3) 1-1/2" x WOF strips, *subcut (2) 1-1/2" x 51-1/2" strips. (24) DRESDEN PETALS FROM TEMPLATE.
	F Crackle Texture 4119-55 Blue	1/8 YD	(6) DRESDEN PETALS FROM TEMPLATE.
	G Crackle Texture 4119-44 Green	1/8 YD	(6) DRESDEN PETALS FROM TEMPLATE.
	H Crackle Texture 4119-01 Pink	1/8 YD	(6) DRESDEN PETALS FROM TEMPLATE.
	I Crackle Texture 4119-77 Beige	1/8 YD	(6) DRESDEN PETALS FROM TEMPLATE.
	J Pin Stripe 4115-55 Blue	1/4 YD	(6) 1-1/2" x 9-1/2" strips. (3) 1-1/2" x WOF strips, *subcut (2) 1-1/2" x 51-1/2" strips.
	K Patchwork 4113-77 Neutral	1/2 YD	(4) 2" x 6-1/2" strips. (4) 2" x 9-1/2" strips. (2) 3-1/2" x 19-1/2" strips. (3) 3-1/2" x WOF strips, subcut (2) 3-1/2" x 53-1/2" strips.

*FIRST SEW STRIPS VIA SHORT ENDS THEN SUBCUT AS INDICATED | WOF=WIDTH OF FABRIC

FINISHING Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When done quilting, trim excess batting and backing. Bind as usual.
