| F Twirling Stars Green 495G-44 | 1/2 yd | (3) $31 / 4 " \times$ WOF strips <br> (2) $31 / 4 " \times$ WOF strips, subcut (8) $31 / 4 " \times 6$ " rectangles |

## BLOCK ASSEMBLY

## Nine Patch Block

1. Sew (1) D $31 / 4$ " $x$ wof strip to each side of (1) B $31 / 4$ " $x$ wof strip. Press seam toward B. Make 2 DBD strip sets. Repeat step sewing (1) B $31 / 4$ " x wof strip to each side of (1) D $31 / 4$ " x wof strip. Press toward B. Make (1) BDB strip set. Subcut (24) $31 / 4$ " DBD strips and (12) BDB strips. Repeat steps to make the following:
(1) ACA strip set - subcut (8) $31 / 4$ " strips

(1) CAC strip set - subcut (4) $31 / 4$ " strips
(1) BEB strip set - subcut (8) $31 / 4$ " strips
(1) EBE strip set - subcut (7) $31 / 4$ " strips
(1) AFA strip set - subcut (6) $31 / 4$ " strips
(1) FAF strip set - subcut (6) $31 / 4 / 4$ strips
2. Nine-Patch Block - Sew (1) DBD strip to the top and bottom of (1) BDB strip to make (1) BD Nine Patch Block. Repeat step to make (12) BD Nine Path Blocks. Square to $83 / 4 /$." Repeat step to make the following:

(4) AC Blocks
(3) BE1 Blocks
(2) BE2 Blocks
(2) AF1 Blocks
(2) AF2 Blocks


## Flying Geese Units

3. Sew (1) G $31 / 4 "$ square to the left side of (1) A $31 / 4$ " $\times 6$ " rectangle on the diagonal. Press toward corner and trim away excess. Sew (1) G $31 / 4$ " square to the right side of A rectangle on the diagonal. Press and trim
 and square to $31 / 4 " \times 6$ ". Make (8) AG Flying Geese Units. Then sew (1) G $31 / 4$ " square to the left side of flying geese unit as shown. Unit will measure $31 / 4 " \times 83 / 4$ ".

Repeat steps to make the following:
(8) BG Flying Geese Units
(16) CG Flying Geese Units
(12) EG Flying Geese Units
(8) FG Flying Geese Units

## SASHING AND BLOCK ROWS

4. Using the Flying Geese Units, (4) G rectangles, (4) G $31 / 4$ " and (36) D $31 / 4$ " squares make sashing rows (refer to diagram for proper placement and rotation).
5. Using the Nine Patch Blocks, (4) G rectangles and Flying Geese Units sew into 5 rows as shown.

## QUILT ASSEMBLY

6. Refer to Quilt Diagram to sew Sashing Row 1 to Nine Patch Row 2 and so on.

## BORDER ASSEMBLY

Measure width and length of your quilt top to ensure border sizes. Below are our cutting sizes.
7. B Border - Sew (1) B $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\mathrm{x}(581 / 4$ ") border strip to the top and bottom of quilt.
8. H Fussy Cut Border - Sew (1) H 6 " $x(581 / 4$ ") fussy cut border strip to top and bottom of quilt.

## FINISHING

Cut batting and backing 3 " larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind as usual. Finished quilt size: $573 / 4$ " $703 / 4$ "
