11. Sew (4) CHAIN BLOCKS together end to end. Make 2. Sew to each side of the quilt.
12. Sew (1) D $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 7 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle to the right side of (1) A $7 \frac{1}{2}$ " square. Sew (1) D $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle to the top of the block. Make 4 LARGE
CORNERSTONE BLOCKS. Square to $81 / 2 \prime 2$. Set aside.

LARGE CORNER STONE BLOCKS 12.
 (MAKE 4)
13. Sew (3) CHAIN BLOCKS together end to end. Sew a LARGE CORNERSTONE BLOCK to each end of the Chain block row, making sure the Cornerstone Blocks are rotated with the Fabric $\mathbf{D}$ strips to the inside as shown. Make 2.

QUILT DIAGRAM


Sew to the top of the quilt, rotate the second row and sew to the bottom of the quilt.
14. D BORDER - Sew (1) D $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x ( 48 1/2") border strip to each side of quilt. Sew (1) D 1 1/2" x (42 1/2") border strip to the top and bottom of quilt.
15. F BORDER - Sew (1) F $5 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times\left(501 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}\right)$ strip to each side of the quilt. Sew (1) B $51 / 2$ " square to each end of (1) F $5 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 42 \frac{1}{2}$ " strip. Make 2. Sew to the top and bottom of the quilt.

Layer quilt, quilt as desired and bind using the D $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.

FINISHING : Cut batting and backing 3 larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing Bind as usual.

## CHAIN BLOCK ASSEMBLY:

1. Sew (1) E $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle to each side of (1) B $21 / 2 "$ square to make Unit 1 .

2. Sew (1) D $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " square to each short end of (1) E $1 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle. Make 2.

3. Sew (1) D and E $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square together on the sides. Make 2. Rotate one of these and sew (2) D/E units together to make a 4 -patch unit. Square to $2 \frac{1}{2}$ ". Make 4. Set aside.
4. Sew (1) C $21 / 2$ " $\times 41 / 2$ " rectangle to each side of the block center.

5. Sew (1) 4-patch unit to each short end of (1) C $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2 "$ rectangle. Make 2. Sew to the top and bottom of the block to complete. Repeat steps 1-6 to make (14) Chain blocks. Square to 8 $1 / 22^{\prime \prime}$. Set aside.

## QUILT ASSEMBLY:

7. Sew (1) D $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 241 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to each side of the A $16 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 241 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ center panel. Sew (1) D $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $181 / 2$ " strip to the top and bottom of the panel center.
8. Sew together the long sides of (1) E 2 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ X $26 \frac{1}{2}$ " and (1) D $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 261 / 2 "$ rect angle. Make 2. Sew (1) to each side of the quilt center, with the $\mathbf{D}$ strip to the outside.


9. Sew (1) D $1 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle to one side of (1) B $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square. Sew (1) D $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle to the top of the unit. Square to $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$. Repeat to make 4 Corner Units. Set aside.
10. As in step 8, sew together the long sides of (1) E $21 / 2$ " $\times 18$ $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ and (1) D $1 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 181 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle. Make 2. Sew (1) corner unit from step 9 to each end of the pieced border unit, making sure the corner unit is rotated to match the Fabric $\mathbf{D}$ strip with the side borders. Make 2. Sew to the top and bottom of the quilt.
