


#### **CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS**

WOF = Width of fabric | LOF = Length of Fabric | HST = Half Square Triangle \*Sew strips via short ends, then subcut as indicated in pattern



### **BLOCK ASSEMBLY**: Refer to **BLOCK DIAGRAMS**

Find the center of (1) D HST and one side of (1) B 7" square.
 Place right sides together, lining up centers, pin, then sew and press. Repeat on remaining (3) sides using (1) D HST and (2) F HSTs to complete BLOCK 1A. Square to 9-1/2", being careful to leave 1/4" seam allowance beyond the points of the HSTs, make (2).



### **BLOCK DIAGRAMS**



Repeat Step 1 using the following squares and HSTs to create remaining blocks. Make number indicated.

> BLOCK 1B (3): B 7" square, (2) E HST, (2) F HST BLOCK 1C (3): B 7" square, (2) E HST, (2) C HST BLOCK 1D (2): B 7" square, (2) C HST, (2) D HST

> BLOCK 2A (1): G 7" square, (2) D HST, (2) F HST BLOCK 2B (2): G 7" square, (2) E HST, (2) F HST BLOCK 2C (2): G 7" square, (2) E HST, (2) C HST BLOCK 2D (1): G 7" square, (2) C HST, (2) D HST

> BLOCK 3A (2): K 7" square, (2) D HST, (2) F HST BLOCK 3B (2): K 7" square, (2) C HST, (2) D HST

## **QUILT ASSEMBLY:** Refer to **QUILT DIAGRAM** for proper block placement and rotation.

3. Sew blocks together into rows for ROWS 2, 4, 6 & 8, then sew rows together.

ROWS 1, 5 & 9: A 7-1/2" X 45-1/2" strip ROWS 3 & 7: A 3-1/2" X 45-1/2" strip ROW 2: 3A - 1A - 2A - 1A - 3A ROW 4: 1B - 2B - 1B - 2B - 1B ROW 6: 1C - 2C - 1C - 2C - 1C

ROW 8: 3B - 1D - 2D - 1D - 3B

BORDER ASSEMBLY: Measure width and length of quilt top to ensure border cutting sizes. Below are our measurements

- 4. Sew (1) J 2" X (63-1/2") strip to each side of quilt, then sew (1) J 2" X (48-1/2") strip to top and bottom of quilt.
- 5. Measure top/bottom of quilt (48-1/2") and cut (2) H 5-1/2" strips to fit, set aside. Sew (1) H 5-1/2" X (66-1/2") strip to each side of quilt. Sew (1) J 5-1/2" square to each end of H 5-1/2" X (48-1/2") strip, make (2), then sew to top and bottom.

#### FINISHING:

Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind with J fabric.
