CUT cut pieces via wof
Fussy cut (1) 22-1/2" x 42-1/2" rectangle, centered on the panel.
(2) $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 3-1/2" squares.
(2) $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 42-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ WOF strips, piece as needed.
(2) $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 26-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ WOF strips.
(3) 2" x WOF strips.*
(2) $2^{\prime \prime} \times 40-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ WOF strips.
(2) $2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 2" $\times 8$ " strips and (4) $2^{\prime \prime} \times 6^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
(7) $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips, BINDING.
Fussy cut (4) 6-1/2" squares, each centered on a medallion.
(1) $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF strip. Subcut (4) 4-1/2" squares.
(1) $2^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) $2^{\prime \prime} \times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
(2) $2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) $2^{\prime \prime} \times 7-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
(1) $2^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $2^{\prime \prime} \times 8$ " strips.
(1) $2^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF strip. Sub-cut
(4) 2 " x 6 " strips.
(2) 2 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) $2^{\prime \prime} \times 7-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
(2) 2 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) $2^{\prime \prime} \times 10-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
(3) 2 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 2" x 8" strips.

BLOCK ASSEMBLY PROJECT USES PRECISE 1/4" SEAMS. TEST YOUR SEAM ALLOWANCE BY CUTTING (2) 2-1/2" X 5" RECTANGLES. STITCH THEM TOGETHER ALONG THE 5" LENGTH. AT THE MIDPOINT, MEASURE ACROSS THE UNIT. IT SHOULD BE EXACTLY 4-1/2" WIDE. IF NOT, ADJUST YOUR SEAM ALLOWANCE AND REPEAT.

## The arrows in the figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations while assembling the various components.

## Block Assembly

1. Sew (1) B $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 42-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to each side of the $\mathbf{A}$ $22-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 42-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ panel. Sew (1) B $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 26-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to the top and to the bottom of the A panel to make the Center Block. Trim the block to measure 25-1/2" x 45-1/2".
2. Sew (1) E 2 " $\times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to each side of (1) D 4-1/2" square. Sew (1) E 2" x 7-1/2" strip to the top and to the bottom of the $\mathbf{D}$ square to make (1) Unit 1 square. Repeat to make (4) Unit 1 squares total.
3. Sew (1) F 2 " $\times 7-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to each side of (1) Unit 1 square. Sew (1) F 2" $\times 10-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 1 square to make (1) Unit 2 square. Repeat to make (4) Unit 2 squares total.

4. Sew (1) G 2 " $\times 6$ " strip to the left side of (1) Unit 2 square, aligning the bottoms of the fabrics. Sew (1) G 2" x 6" strip to the right side of the Unit 1 square, aligning the tops of the fabrics. Sew (1) G 2" x 8" strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 2 square, aligning with the G strips sewn previously to make (1) Unit 3 piece. Repeat to make (4) Unit 3 pieces total.

5. Repeat Step 4 and refer to the figures below for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (4) Unit 4 pieces and (4) Unit 5 pieces.

6. Repeat Step 4 and refer to the figures below for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (2) of each unit piece for Unit 6 through
Unit 11.

7. Trim the Unit 11 pieces to measure $6 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 45 \frac{1}{2}$ " to make the (2) Side Borders.

8. Place (1) B 3-1/2" square on the top left corner of (1) C 6-1/2" square, right sides together. Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner. Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle $1 / 4$ " away from the sewn seam.

9. Follow the figures below for the seam direction to add a B 3-1/2" square to each of the remaining corners of the C 6-1/2" square to make (1) Unit 12 square.
10. Repeat Steps 8-9 to make (4) Unit $\mathbf{1 2}$ squares total.

11. Repeat Step 4 and add the $\mathbf{B}$ strips to each of the (2) remaining Unit 5 pieces to make (2) Unit 13 pieces.

12. Trim the Unit 13 pieces to measure $6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 25-1 / 2$ to make (2) Unit 14 strips.

13. Sew (1) Unit 12 square to each end of (1) Unit 14 strip to make the Top Border. Repeat to make the Bottom Border.


## Quilt Assembly

14. Sew (1) Side Border to each side of the Center Block. Sew the Top Border and Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

BORDER ASSEMBLY MEASURE WIDTH AND LENGTH OF THE QUILT TOP TO ENSURE B AND L BORDER SIZES, BELOW ARE OUR CUTTING SIZES.
15. Sew (1) B $2^{\prime \prime} \times\left(57-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) B 2" x 40-1/2" strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
16. Sew (1) L 6-1/2" $x\left(60-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) L 6-1/2" x (52-1/2") strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

FINISHING Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind as usual.
