CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

WOF = Width of fabric | *Sew strips via short ends, then subcut as indicated in pattern

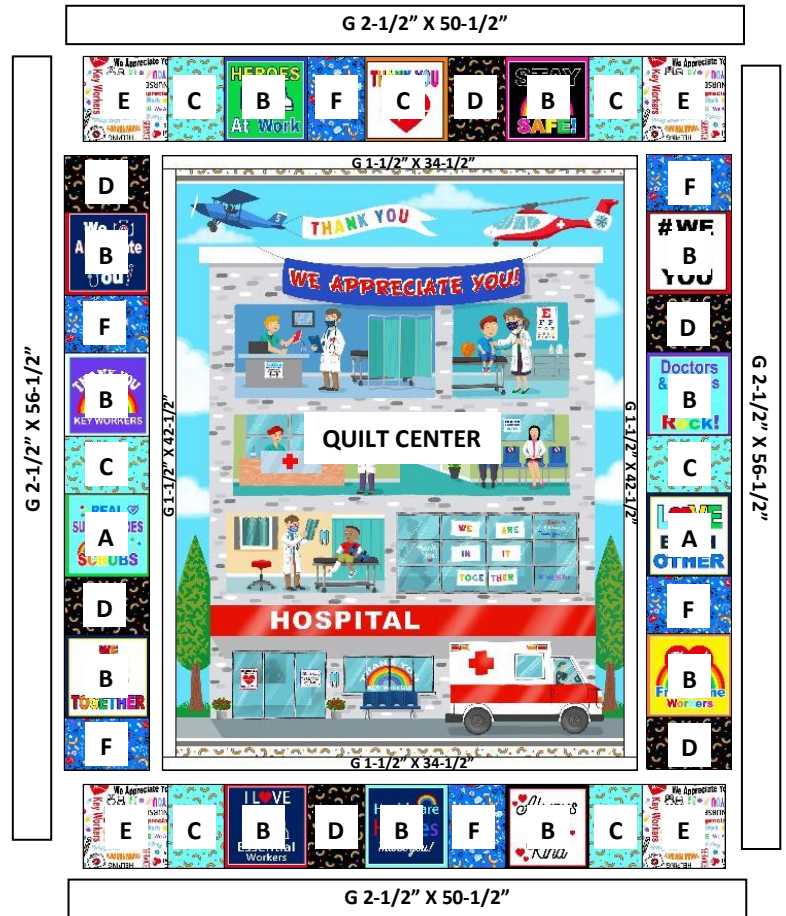

QUILT ASSEMBLY: Refer to QUILT DIAGRAM

1. Sew (1) **G** 1-1/2" X 42-1/2" strip to each side of **A** 32-1/2" X 42-1/2" panel, then sew (1) **G** 1-1/2" X 34-1/2" strip to top and bottom to create **QUILT CENTER**.
2. Following quilt diagram, sew squares and rectangles together to create **BORDER UNITS**, then sew to **QUILT CENTER** (sides first, then top and bottom).
3. Sew (1) **G** 2-1/2" X 56-1/2" strip to each side of quilt, then sew (1) **G** 2-1/2" X 50-1/2" strip to top and bottom.

FINISHING:

Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind with **D** fabric.
