

## QUILT DIAGRAM

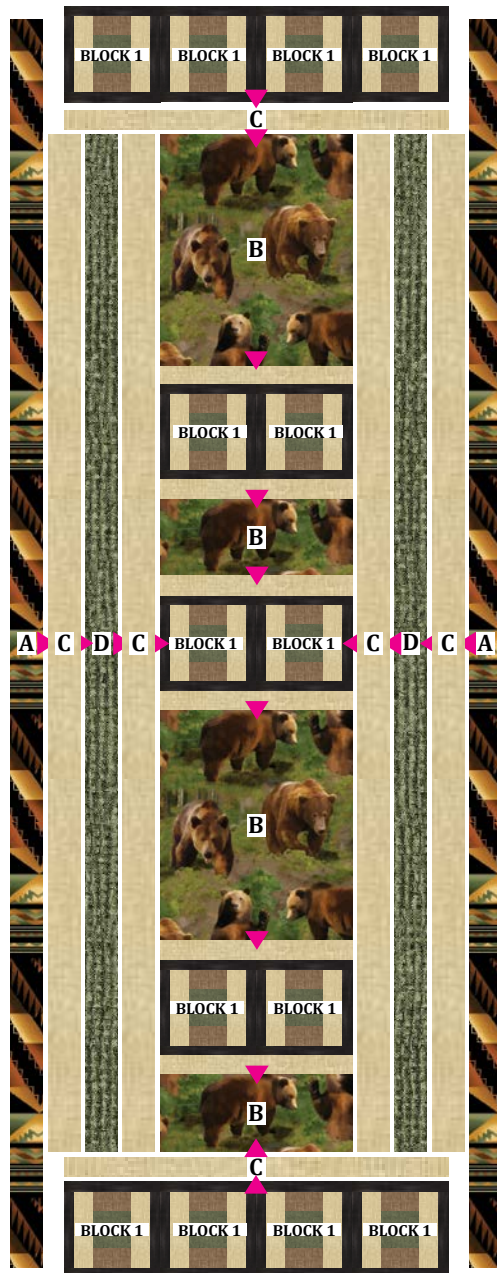
**BORDER ASSEMBLY** *MEASURE WIDTH AND LENGTH OF THE QUILT TOP TO ENSURE BORDER SIZES, BELOW ARE OUR CUTTING SIZES.*

**6. CDC BORDER:** Sew (1) C 2" x (53 1/2") strip to each side of (1) D 2 1/2" x (53 1/2") strip. Make 2 CDC strips and sew one to each side of quilt top.

**7.** Sew (1) C 1 1/2" x (20 1/2") strip to top and bottom of quilt top. Sew (4) **Block 1s** into a row as shown. *Make 2 rows.* Sew (1) row to the top and to the bottom of the quilt center.

**8.** Sew (1) A 2 1/2" x (65 1/2) strip to each side of quilt top.

**FINISHING :** Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind as usual.

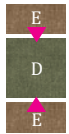

	<b>C</b> Burlap Solids 757-71 <i>Straw</i>	7/8 YD	(6) 2" x WOF strips*; border (2) 4 1/2" x WOF strips, subcut (28) 1 1/2" x 4 1/2" strips (2) 1 1/2" x WOF strips, subcut (6) 1 1/2" x 10 1/2" strips (2) 1 1/2" x 20 1/2" strips
	<b>D</b> Burlap Solids 757-44 <i>Green</i>	3/8 YD	(3) 2 1/2" x WOF strips*; border (1) 2 1/2" x WOF strip, subcut (14) 2 1/2" squares
	<b>E</b> Burlap Solids 757-78 <i>Nutmeg</i>	1/8 YD	(2) 1 1/2" x WOF strips, subcut (28) 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" strips
	<b>F</b> Fleurish 5619-12 <i>Black</i>	3/4 YD	(1) 4 1/2" x WOF strip, subcut (28) 1" x 4 1/2" strips (1) 5 1/2" x WOF strip, subcut (28) 1" x 5 1/2" strips (5) 2 1/2" x WOF strips*; binding

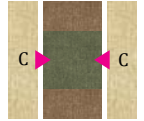
WOF = WIDTH OF FABRIC | \*SEW STRIPS VIA SHORT ENDS, THEN SUBCUT AS INDICATED

## BLOCK 1 ASSEMBLY

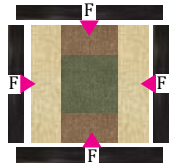
1. Sew (1) **E** 2 1/2" x 1 1/2" rectangle to top and bottom of (1) **D** 2 1/2" square. *Make 14.*



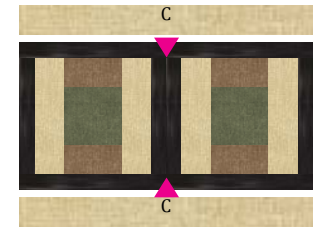
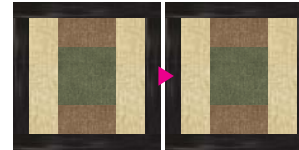
2. Sew (1) **C** 1 1/2" x 4 1/2" strip to each side of sewn unit. *Make 14.*



3. Sew (1) **F** 1" x 4 1/2" rectangle to each side of sewn unit. Sew (1) **F** 1" x 5 1/2" strip to the top and bottom of sewn unit to complete **BLOCK 1**. Square to 5 1/2". *Make 14.*



4. Sew (2) **BLOCK 1s** together. Sew (1) **C** 1 1/2" x 10 1/2" rectangle to top and bottom of sewn unit. *Make 3.*



5. Sew **BLOCK 1** and **B BLOCKS** together according to the quilt diagram as shown. The center unit should measure 10 1/2" x 53 1/2".
