
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

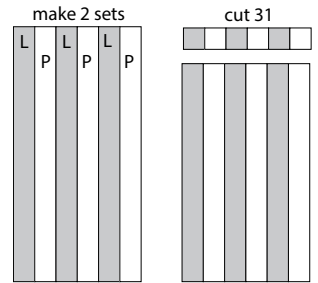

	<b>P</b> Plain White White	1-2/3 yds	(2) 12-1/2" x WOF, sub-cut (6) 12-1/2" x 12-1/2" (2) 6-1/2" x WOF, sub-cut (12) 6-1/2" x 6-1/2" (6) 2-1/2" x WOF (1) 2-1/2" x WOF, sub-cut (10) 2-1/2" x 2-1/2"

BLOCK ASSEMBLY PROJECT USES PRECISE 1/4" SEAMS. TEST YOUR SEAM ALLOWANCE BY CUTTING (2) 2-1/2" X 5" RECTANGLES. STITCH THEM TOGETHER ALONG THE 5" LENGTH. AT THE MIDPOINT, MEASURE ACROSS THE UNIT. IT SHOULD BE EXACTLY 4-1/2" WIDE. IF NOT, ADJUST YOUR SEAM ALLOWANCE AND REPEAT.

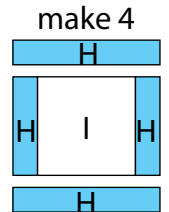
### BLOCK ASSEMBLY

1. Sew (3) 2-1/2" x WOF **L** strips and (3) 2-1/2" x WOF **P** strips together, lengthwise and alternating them, to make (1) **LP** strip set. Repeat to make a second **LP** strip set.

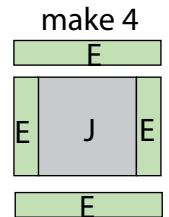


2. Cut the **LP** strip sets into (31) 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" **LP** strips.

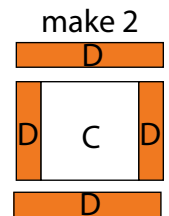
3. Sew (1) 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" **H** strip to each side of (1) 4-1/2" **I** square. Sew (1) 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" **H** strip to the top and to the bottom of the **I** square to make (1) **I-block**. Repeat to make (4) **I-blocks** total.



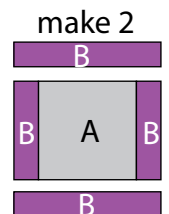
4. Sew (1) 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" **E** strip to each side of (1) 4-1/2" **J** square. Sew (1) 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" **E** strip to the top and to the bottom of the **J** square to make (1) **J-block**. Repeat to make (4) **J-blocks** total.



5. Sew (1) 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" **D** strip to each side of (1) 4-1/2" **C** square. Sew (1) 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" **D** strip to the top and to the bottom of the **C** square to make (1) **C-block**. Repeat to make (2) **C-blocks** total.



6. Sew (1) 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" **B** strip to each side of (1) 4-1/2" **A** square. Sew (1) 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" **B** strip to the top and to the bottom of the **A** square to make (1) **A-block**. Repeat to make (2) **A-blocks** total.

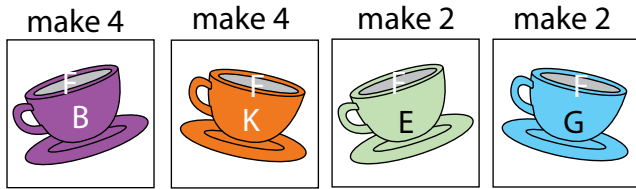


\* SEW STRIPS VIA SHORT ENDS THEN GO TO BORDER ASSEMBLY

7. Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace the listed number of each template onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out each template about 1/8" outside the drawn lines.

8. Press each template onto the wrong side of the fabrics as listed on the templates. Cut out each template on the drawn lines.

9. Refer to the quilt photo to arrange and press the (12) **Cups** and (12) **Coffees** onto (12) 6-1/2" **P** squares.



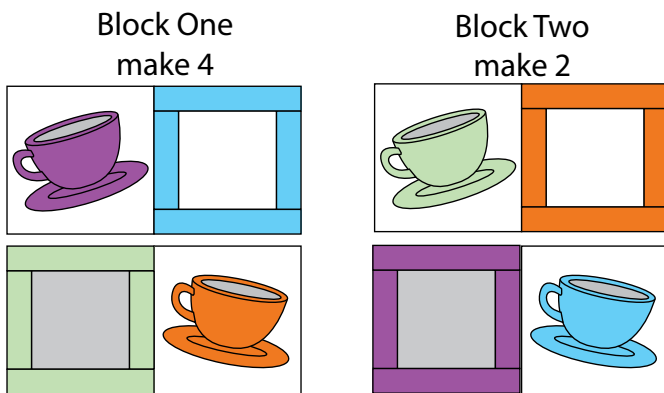
10. Repeat Step 9 to arrange the (6) **Pots** onto the (6) 12-1/2" **P** squares. (Fig. 8)



11. Finish the raw edges of each shape with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch to complete the (6) **Pot Blocks** and the (12) **Cup Blocks**.

12. Sew (2) **Cup Blocks**, (1) **I-block** and (1) **J-block** together to make (1) **Block One**. Repeat to make (4) **Block Ones** total.

13. Sew (2) **Cup Blocks**, (1) **C-block** and (1) **A-block** together to make (1) **Block Two**. Repeat to make a second **Block Two**.



14. Sew (3) **LP** strips together, (2) 2-1/2" **P** squares and (2) 2-1/2" **L** squares together, end to end, to make (1) **Sashing Strip**. Pay attention to the orientation of the **LP** strips and the position of the 2-1/2" squares. Repeat to make (5) **Sashing Strips** total.

## QUILT ASSEMBLY

15. Sew (4) **LP** strips, (2) **Pot Blocks** and (1) **Block Two** together to make **Row One**. Repeat to make **Row Three**.

16. Sew (4) **LP** strips, (2) **Block Ones** and (1) **Pot Block** to gether to make **Row Two**. Repeat to make **Row Four**.

17. Sew the (5) **Sashing Strips** and (4) Rows, in numerical order, together, alternating them, to make the quilt top.

**BORDER ASSEMBLY** *MEASURE WIDTH AND LENGTH OF THE QUILT TOP TO ENSURE H AND M BORDER SIZES, BELOW ARE OUR CUTTING SIZES.*

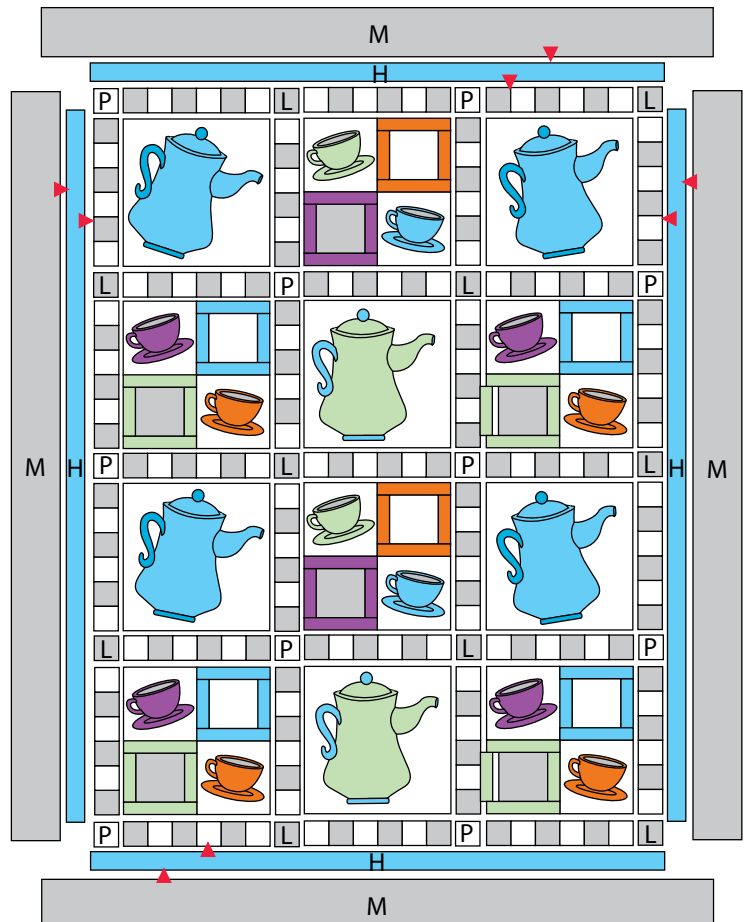
18. Sew (1) **H** 2" x (58-1/2") strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew (1) **H** 2" x (47-1/2") strips to the top and bottom of quilt top.

19. Sew (1) **M** 4-1/2" x (61-1/2") strip to each sides of the quilt top. Sew **M** (1) 4-1/2" (55-1/2") strip to the top and to the bottom of the quilt top.

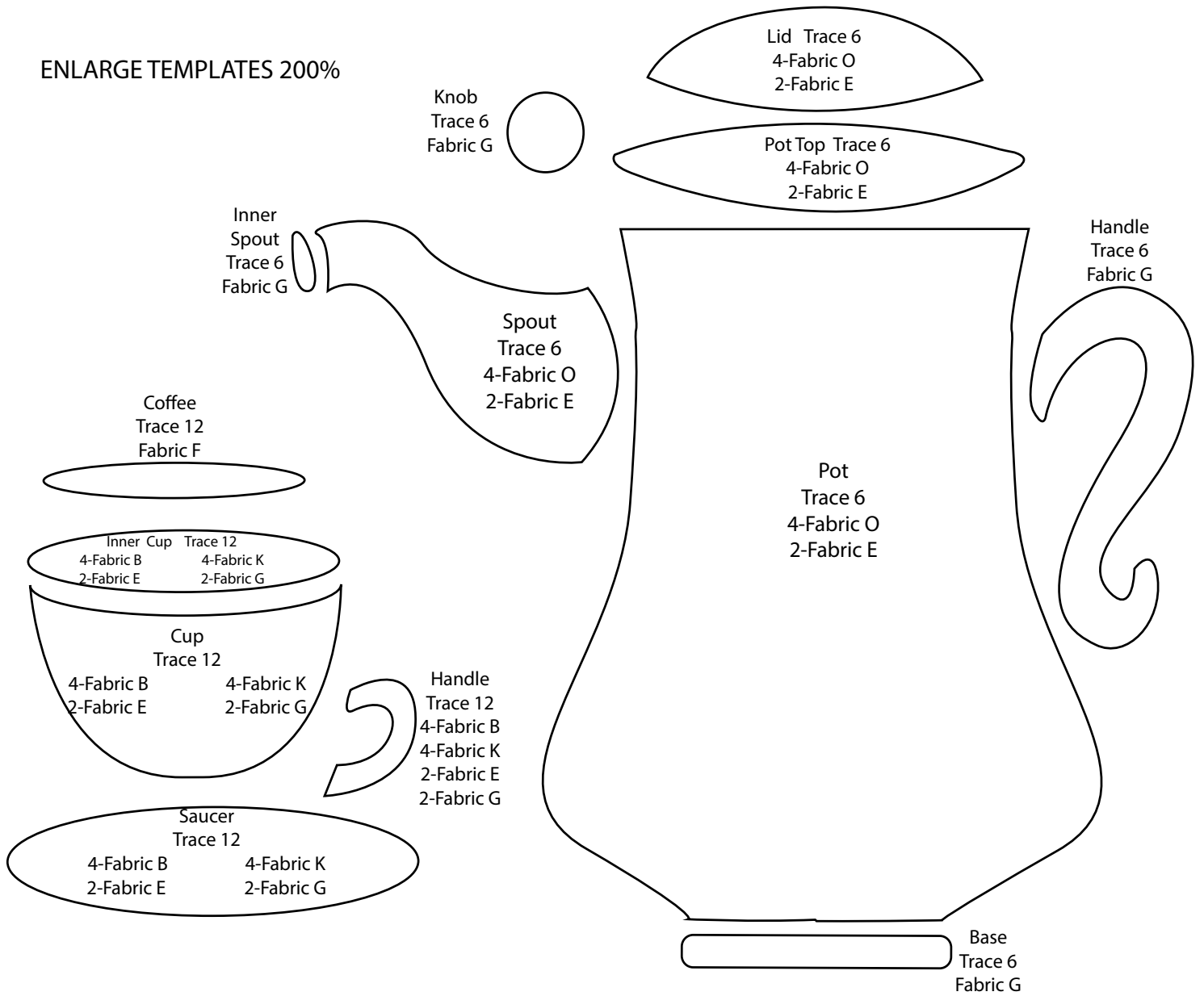
**FINISHING** Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind as usual.

**FINISHED SIZE: 55" x 69"**
