SAMPLE KEY/SKU	QTY	CUT	WOF = Width of Fabric *Sew strips via short ends, then subcut as indicated.
A Burlap Foulard Blue Fresca 753-05	2 ¼ yd	(2) 10 ¼" x WOF strips, subcut (5) 10 ¼" squares cut twice on diagonal (1A) (2) 5 ¾" x WOF strips, subcut (14) 5 ¾" squares cut twice on diagonal (2A) (13) 1 ¾" x WOF strips*; border (7) 2 ¼" x WOF strips*; binding	
B Lacey Paisley Fresca Blue 752-05	1 yd	(3) 9 7/8" x WOF strips, subcut (9) 9 7/8" squares cut once on diagonal (1B)	
C Lace Foulard Natural 756-70	1 1/2 yd	(2) 10 ¼" x WOF strips, subcut (5) 10 ¼" squares cut twice on diagonal (1C) (2) 5 3/8" x WOF strips, subcut (8) 5 3/8" squares cut once on diagonal (2C) (2) 5 ¾" x WOF strips, subcut (14) 5 ¾" squares cut twice on diagonal (3C) (6) 1 ½" x WOF strips*; border	
D Burlap Floral Pale Fresca Blue 751-05	3/4 yd	(4) 5 3/8" x WOF strips, subcut (26) 5 3/8" squares cut once on diagonal (1D)	
E Burlap Foulard Vanilla 753-07	5/8 yd	(3) 5 ¾" x WOF strips, subcut (17) 5 ¾" squares cut twice on diagonal (1E)	
F Burlap Floral Espresso 751-77	3/4 yd	(4) 5 3/8" x WOF strips, subcut (28) 5 3/8" squares cut once on diagonal (1F)	
G Medallion Squares Espresso/Blue 750-77	1 yd	(8) 5" squares fussy cut with blue centers (9) 5" squares fussy cut with brown centers	

BLOCK ASSEMBLY:

1. Y Block - Sew (1) 1A triangle to the right side of (1) 1C triangle to make AC triangle unit. Sew (1) 1B triangle base to the base of (1) AC triangle unit. Square to 9 ½". Repeat steps to make (18) ACB-Y Squares.



2. GE Units - Sew (1) 1E triangle to opposite sides of (1) G-Brown Center 5" square. Sew (1) 1E triangle to each remaining side of (1) GE unit. Square to 6 ¾". Make 9 Brown GE units. Repeat steps using G-Blue Center 5" squares to make 8 Blue GE units.



3. GED Brown Center Squares - Sew (1) 1D triangle to opposite sides of (1) Brown GE unit. Sew (1) 1D triangle to each remaining side of (1) GED units to make GED square. Square to 9 ½". Make 5 Brown GED Squares. Repeat steps using 3C triangles to make 4 Brown GEC Squares.



4. GED Blue Center Squares - Repeat Step 3 using 1D triangles to make 8 Blue GED Squares.



QUILT CENTER ASSEMBLY

5. Assemble the quilt center as shown in Quilt Diagram noting the proper rotation of the Y Blocks in each row.

BORDER ASSEMBLY

Measure width and length of quilt top to ensure C and A border cutting sizes. Below are our sizes. Sew (2) WOF border strips together at short ends. Sew border to (1) side of quilt and trim even with quilt top and bottom. Use remaining portion of strip and sew to next WOF strip. Sew to other side of quilt. Repeat for top and bottom of quilt to finish.

6. C Border - Sew (1) C 1 ½" x (63 ½") border strip to each side of quilt center. Sew (1) C 1 ½" x (47 ½") border strip to the top and bottom of quilt center.

7. A Border - Sew (1) A 1 ¾" x (65 ½") border strip to each side of quilt center. Sew (1) A 1 ¾" x (50") border strip to the top and bottom of quilt center.

8. Border Y Squares - Sew (1) 2A triangle to the right side of (1) 2C triangle to make AC triangle unit. Make 56 AC units. Sew (1) 1F triangle base to the base of (1) AC triangle unit to make (1) Y Square. Square to 5". Repeat steps to make 56 ACF-Y Squares.

9. Y Square Border - Refer to Quilt Diagram to sew (15) Y squares together vertically. (Note proper rotation of squares.) Make 2 vertical rows. Sew (1) Y Row to each side of quilt. Then sew (13) Y squares together horizontally. (Note proper rotation of squares.) Make 2 horizontal rows. Sew (1) Y Row to the top and bottom of quilt.

10. A Border - Sew (1) A 1 ¾" x (77") border strip to each side of quilt. Sew (1) A 1 ¾" x (61 ½") border strip to the top and bottom of quilt top.

FINISHING

Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind as usual.

FINISHED QUILT SIZE: 61" x 79"
BLOCK SIZE: - 9" finished
