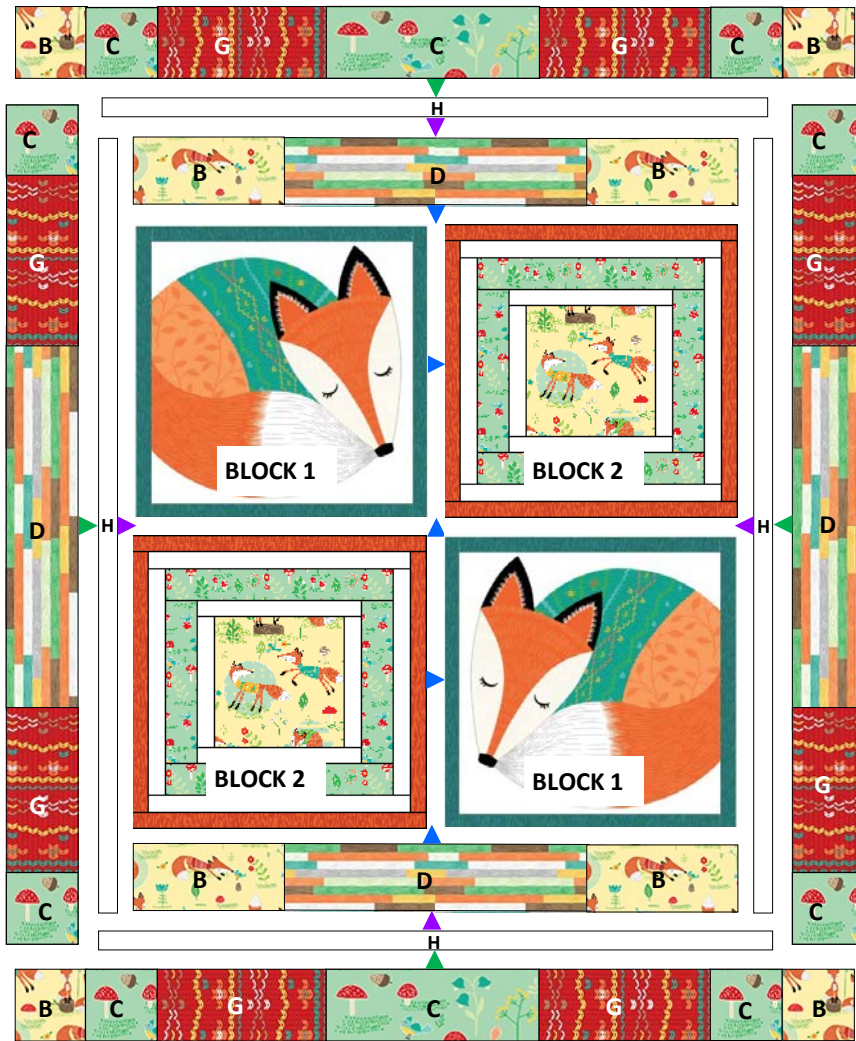


FINISHING: Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. Quilt as desired. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind as usual.



BLOCK ASSEMBLY: *Refer to BLOCK DIAGRAMS for proper fabric placement.*

BLOCK 1:

1. Following the manufacturers instructions fuse (1) **A** Rusty motif to (1) **H** 16-1/2" square. Note: You will have to trim some of the Rusty motif for it to fit onto the **H** square - refer to cover image. *Optional - sew around the motif using your favorite applique stitch.* Sew (1) **F** 1-1/2" X 16-1/2" strip to the top and bottom, then sew (1) **F** 1-1/2" X 18-1/2" strip to each side. Square to 18-1/2", make (2).

BLOCK 2:

2. Sew **H**, **C**, **H** and **E** strips to (1) **B** 8-1/2" square as follows:
H 1-1/2" X 8-1/2" to sides, then **H** 1-1/2" X 10-1/2" to top and bottom
C 2-1/2" X 10-1/2" to sides, then **C** 14-1/2" X 2-1/2" to top and bottom
H 1-1/2" X 14-1/2" to sides, then **H** 1-1/2" X 16-1/2" to top and bottom
E 1-1/2" X 16-1/2" to sides, then **E** 1-1/2" X 18-1/2" to top and bottom
 3. Square to 18-1/2", make (2).

BLOCK 1 (make 2)

QUILT ASSEMBLY: *Refer to QUILT DIAGRAM*

4. Sew blocks together as shown on quilt diagram to create **QUILT CENTER**.
 5. Sew (1) **B** 5" X 9-1/2" rectangle to the each side of (1) **D** 5" X 18-1/2" rectangle to create **BDB UNIT**. Make (2), then sew to top and bottom of **QUILT CENTER**.

BORDER ASSEMBLY: *Measure width and length of quilt top to ensure border cutting sizes. Below are our measurements.*

6. Sew (1) **H** 1-1/2" X (45-1/2) strip to each side of quilt, then sew (1) **H** 1-1/2" X (38-1/2) strip to top and bottom.
 7. Sew the following together along the 5" side to create **SIDE BORDER UNIT**. Make (2), then sew to sides of quilt.
C 5" square - **G** 5" X 9-1/2" rectangle - **D** 5" X 20-1/2" rectangle - **G** 5" X 9-1/2" rectangle - **C** 5" square
 8. Sew the following together along the 5" side to create **TOP/BOTTOM BORDER UNIT**. Make (2), then sew to top and bottom of quilt.
B 5" square - **C** 5" square - **G** 5" X 9-1/2" rectangle - **C** 5" X 11-1/2" rectangle - **G** 5" X 9-1/2" rectangle - **C** 5" square - **B** 5" square
