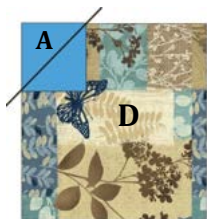

BLOCK ASSEMBLY

BLOCK 1:

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) **A** 3 1/2" block. Place a square on the top left corner of **D** 9 1/2" block. Sew on the diagonal line. Trim 1/4" seam allowance and press to the corner. Repeat on the remaining corners of the block to create **BLOCK 1**. *Make 18.*

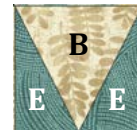
BLOCK 2:

2. Sew **C** and **F** 2" square together along one side. *Make 2.* Sew the two units together to make a 4 patch unit. Square to 3-1/2"

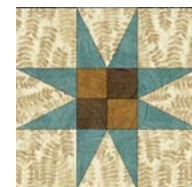


4 PATCH UNIT
(Make 18)

3. Sew the long diagonal side of a **Template B and C** (Fabric E) to both sides of the **B** triangle (**Template A**) to complete the **STAR POINT UNIT**. Square to 3-1/2". *Make 4.* Sew a star point unit to both sides of the 4 patch unit as shown below. Sew (1) **B** 3 1/2" square to each side of a star point unit as shown below. *Make 2.* Sew one to the top of the 4 patch row, and rotate the second unit and sew to the bottom of the block to complete **BLOCK 2**. Square to 9-1/2". *Make 18.*

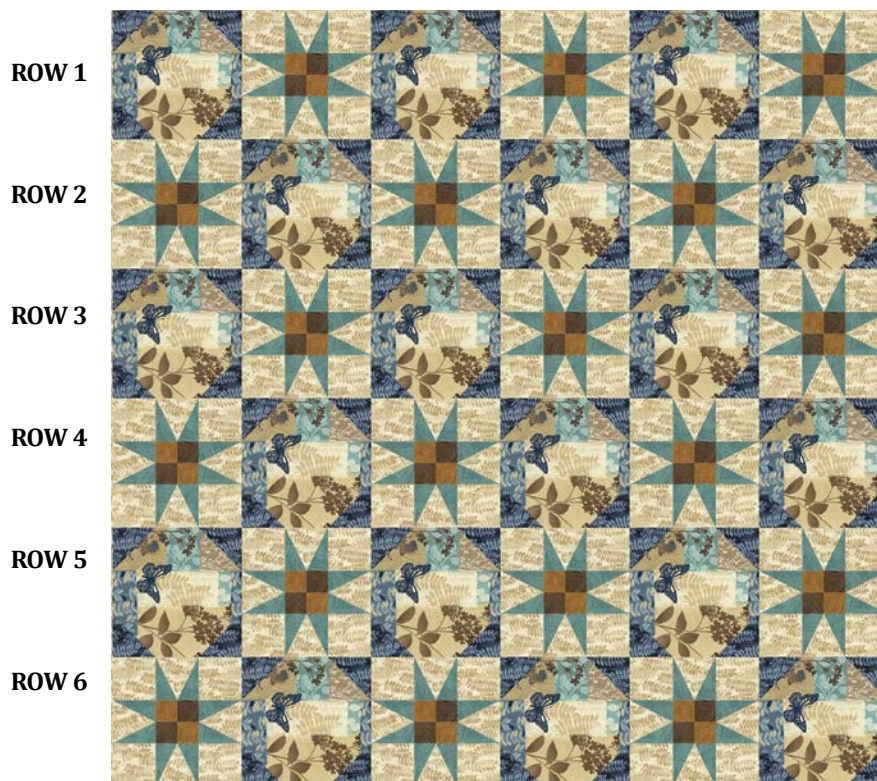
BLOCK 2

4. The quilt center is made of 6 rows of 6 blocks, alternating **BLOCK 1** and **BLOCK 2** and continue across, alternating the blocks. Start the second row with **BLOCK 2**. Continue until all 6 rows are completed. Sew rows 1-6 together with horizontal seams until the quilt center is completed.

ROW DIAGRAM

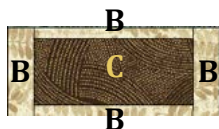


INNER BORDER:

5. Sew **B** $2\frac{1}{4}$ " x $54\frac{1}{2}$ " strips to each side of quilt center. Sew **B** $2\frac{1}{4}$ " x 58 " strips to the top and bottom of the quilt.

OUTER BORDER:

6. **SIDE BLOCKS:** Sew (1) **B** $\frac{3}{4}$ " x $4\frac{3}{8}$ " rectangle to both long sides of (1) **C** $2\frac{1}{8}$ " x $4\frac{3}{8}$ " rectangle. Sew (1) **B** $1\frac{1}{8}$ " x $2\frac{5}{8}$ " rectangle to both sides to make the block center. Sew (1) **E** $1\frac{7}{8}$ " x $5\frac{1}{4}$ " rectangle to the top and (1) to the bottom of the block center. Sew (1) Fabric **E** $3\frac{3}{4}$ " x $5\frac{1}{4}$ " rectangle to both sides to complete the rectangular blocks. They should be $5\frac{1}{4}$ " x 12 " unfinished. *Make 20.* Sew 5 rectangular border blocks together end to end to create **SIDE BORDERS**. *Make 4.* Sew (1) **SIDE BORDER** to right and (1) to left side of quilt center. *(See Quilt Diagram)*



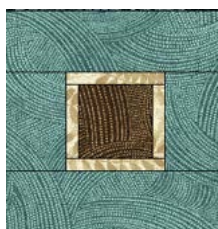
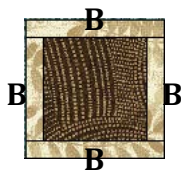

CORNER BLOCKS:

7. Sew (1) **B** $\frac{3}{4}$ " x $2-1/8$ " rectangle to the sides of (1) **C** $2-1/8$ " square. Sew (1) **B** $\frac{3}{4}$ " x $2-5/8$ " rectangle to the top and bottom of the center. Sew (1) **E** $1-7/8$ " x $2-5/8$ " rectangle to the sides. Sew (1) **E** $1-7/8$ " x $5\frac{1}{4}$ " rectangle to the top and (1) to bottom to complete **CORNER BLOCK**. Square to $5-1/4$ ". *Make 4.*



CORNER BLOCK
(Make 4)

8. Sew (1) **CORNER BLOCK** to each side of a **SIDE BORDER** strip. Then sew (1) to the top and (1) to bottom of quilt center.

QUILT DIAGRAM



FINISHING : Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind as usual.

Finished Quilt Size: 67" W x 67" L
