	Fancy A 5106-05 Aqua	1/2 yd	(1) 15-1/2" x 21-1/2" strip.
	Random B 5110-42 Lettuce	1-1/8 yds	(2) 2" x 21-1/2" strips. (1) 2" x WOF strip, sub-cut (2) 2" x 18-1/2" strips. (5) 2" x WOF strips* (7) 2-1/2" x WOF strips, BINDING
	Happy Stripe C 5109-44 Willow/Multi	3/8 yd	(3) 3-1/2" x WOF strips, sub-cut (28) 3-1/2" squares.
	Random D 5110-30 Butter	1/2 yd	(3) 3-1/2" x WOF strips, sub-cut (28) 3-1/2" squares. See instructions to cut (16) flower centers.
	Free E 5108-60 Violet	1/4 yd	(1) 6 1/2" x WOF strip, sub-cut (4) 6-1/2" squares.
	Just Daisies F 5107-40 Willow	1/2 yd	(4) 3-1/2" x 36-1/2" WOF strips.
	Window Pane G 5111-36 Violet/Multi	1-1/2 yds	(4) 9-1/2" x WOF strips, sub-cut (2) 9-1/2" x 42-1/2" strips and (2) 9-1/2" x 36-1/2" strips.
	Just Daisies H 5107-24 Aqua	1/3 yd	(1) 9-1/2" x WOF strip, sub-cut (4) 9-1/2" squares.
	Just Daisies I 5107-60 Violet	1-1/8 yds	(8) 4-1/2" x WOF strips*
	Burlap J 757-60 Violet	1/2 yd	See instructions to cut (8) flowers.
	Random K 5110-02 Rose	1/2 yd	See instructions to cut (8) flowers and (4) flower centers.
	Burlap L 757-54 Azure	1/3 yd	See instructions to cut (4) flowers.
	Burlap M 757-48 Olive	3/4 yd	See instructions to cut (22) stems.

* SEW STRIPS VIA SHORT ENDS THEN GO TO BORDER ASSEMBLY
WOF/LOF=WIDTH/LENGTH OF FABRIC

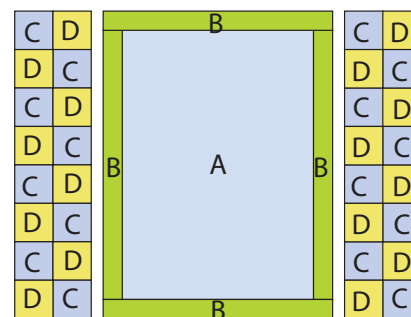
BLOCK ASSEMBLY *PROJECT USES PRECISE 1/4" SEAMS. TEST YOUR SEAM ALLOWANCE BY CUTTING (2) 2-1/2" X 5" RECTANGLES. STITCH THEM TOGETHER ALONG THE 5" LENGTH. AT THE MIDPOINT, MEASURE ACROSS THE UNIT. IT SHOULD BE EXACTLY 4-1/2" WIDE. IF NOT, ADJUST YOUR SEAM ALLOWANCE AND REPEAT.*

QUILT ASSEMBLY

1. Sew (1) **B** 2" x 21-1/2" strip to each side of (1) **A** 15-1/2" x 21-1/2" strip. Sew (1) **B** 2" x 18-1/2" strip to the top and to the bottom of the **A** strip to make the **Center Block**.

2. Sew (8) **C** 3-1/2" squares and (8) **D** 3-1/2" squares together into a 6-1/2" x 24-1/2" checkerboard strip. Repeat to make a second checkerboard strip. Sew (1) strip to each side of the **Center Block**.

3. Sew (6) **C** 3-1/2" squares and (6) **D** 3-1/2" squares together into a 6-1/2" x 18-1/2" checkerboard strip. Repeat to make a second checkerboard strip. Sew (1) **E** 6-1/2" square to each end of the checkerboard strips. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the **Center Block**.



4. Sew (1) **F** 3-1/2" x 36-1/2" strip to each side of the center square. Sew (1) **F** 3-1/2" x 36-1/2" strip to the top and to the bottom of the center square.

5. Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace the listed number of each template onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out each template about 1/8" outside the drawn lines.

6. Press each template onto the wrong side of the fabrics as listed on the templates. Cut out each template on the drawn lines.

7. Refer to the Quilt Layout to arrange and (20) flowers, (20) flower centers and (22) stems onto (2) **G** 9-1/2" x 42-1/2" and (2) **G** 9-1/2" x 36-1/2" borders.

8. Finish the raw edges of each shape with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch.

9. Sew (1) **G** 9-1/2" x 42-1/2" strip to each side of the quilt top.

10. Sew (1) **H** 9-1/2" square to each end of the (2) **G** 9 1/2" x 36-1/2" strips. Sew the strips to the top and bottom of the quilt top.

BORDER ASSEMBLY *MEASURE WIDTH AND LENGTH OF THE QUILT TOP TO ENSURE B and I BORDER SIZES, BELOW ARE OUR CUTTING SIZES.*

11. Sew (1) **B** 2" x (60-1/2") strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew (1) **B** 2" x (57-1/2") strips to the top and bottom of quilt top.

12. Sew (1) **I** 4-1/2" x (63-1/2") strip to each sides of the quilt top. Sew (1) **I** 4-1/2" x (65-1/2") strip to the top and bottom of quilt top.

FINISHING Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind as usual.
