
5. Create Quilt in rows using **Blocks 1-6**, 3" squares and 3" x 10 ½" strips following the **Quilt Diagram** below.



FINISHING

Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind as usual. Finished Size: 40" x 52-1/2"



BLOCK ASSEMBLY

1. BLOCK 1: Draw a diagonal line on the **G** 3" squares. Place (1) **G** 3" square on the left side of (1) **V** 3" x 5 ½" rectangle. Sew on the diagonal line. Press to the corner. Trim off the excess. Repeat step with (1) **A** 3" square on the right side of **V** rectangle to create **GVA Unit**. Then sew (1) **E** 3" square to left and right side of **GVA Unit** to make **EGVA Unit**. *Make 2*.












2. Create the second Unit using the instructions in Step 1 and replacing the fabrics following the diagram below.

3. Sew (1) **B** 3" square to right side of (1) **D** 3" then sew another **D** and **B** square together and sew to the bottom as shown in the **BLOCK 1** diagram below to create **Block 1 Center.** Then sew (1) **HVG Unit** to left and (1) to right side of **Block 1 Center.** Then sew (1) **EGVA Unit** to top and (1) to bottom on **Block 1 Center.** Square to 10 ½".



4. Create the remaining blocks using the instructions in Steps 1,2 and 3 and replacing the fabrics following the diagrams below.
