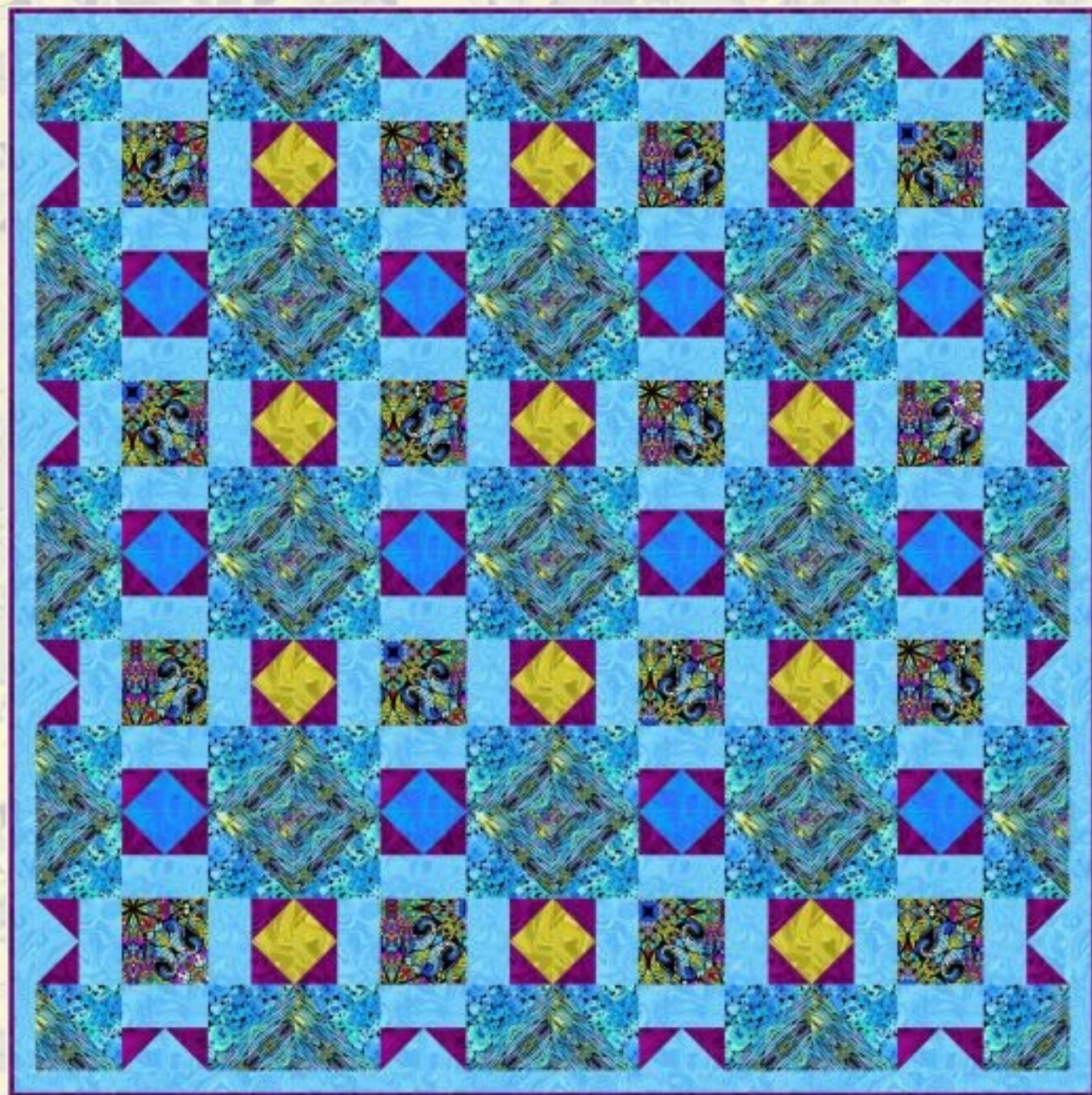

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

*WOF = Width of fabric | LOF = Length of fabric | HST = Half Square Triangle | *Sew strips via short ends, then subcut as indicated in pattern*

UNIT ASSEMBLY: Refer to **UNIT DIAGRAMS**

- Draw diagonal line on the wrong side of all (128) **G** 2-1/2" squares.

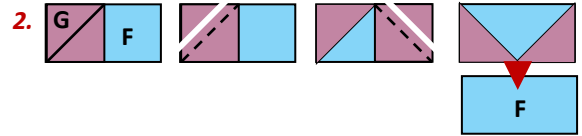
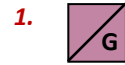
UNITS 1, 2 and 3:

- Place (1) **G** 2-1/2" square right sides together on one side of (1) **F** 2-1/2" X 4-1/2" rectangle. Sew on diagonal line, trim seam allowance to 1/4", then press open to make **FG UNIT**. Sew (1) **F** 2-1/2" X 4-1/2" rectangle to **FG UNIT** to create **UNIT 1**. Square to 4-1/2", make (16).
- As in step 2, use **G** 2-1/2" squares, **D** 2-1/2" X 4-1/2" rectangles and **F** 2-1/2" X 4-1/2" rectangles to create **UNIT 2**. Square to 4-1/2", make (24).
- As in step 2, use **G** 2-1/2" squares, **E** 2-1/2" X 4-1/2" rectangles and **F** 2-1/2" X 4-1/2" rectangles to create **UNIT 3**. Square to 4-1/2", make (24).

UNIT 4

- Sew (1) **B** HST and (1) **C** HST together to create **UNIT 4**. Square to 4-1/2", make (64).

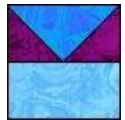

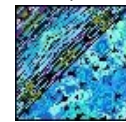
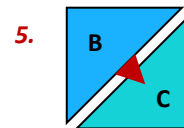
UNIT 1 (make 16)

BLOCK ASSEMBLY: Refer to **BLOCK DIAGRAMS**

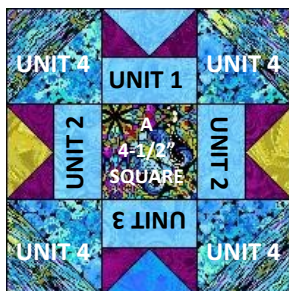
- Sew units and squares together into rows, then sew rows together as shown in diagrams to create **BLOCKS 1, 2, 3, 4** and **5**. Square all blocks to 12-1/2", make number indicated.

BLOCK 1 (make 2)



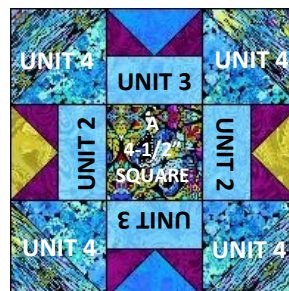
BLOCK 2 (make 4)



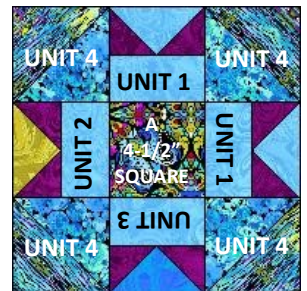
BLOCK 3 (make 4)

QUILT ASSEMBLY: *Refer to **QUILT DIAGRAM** for proper block placement and rotation.*

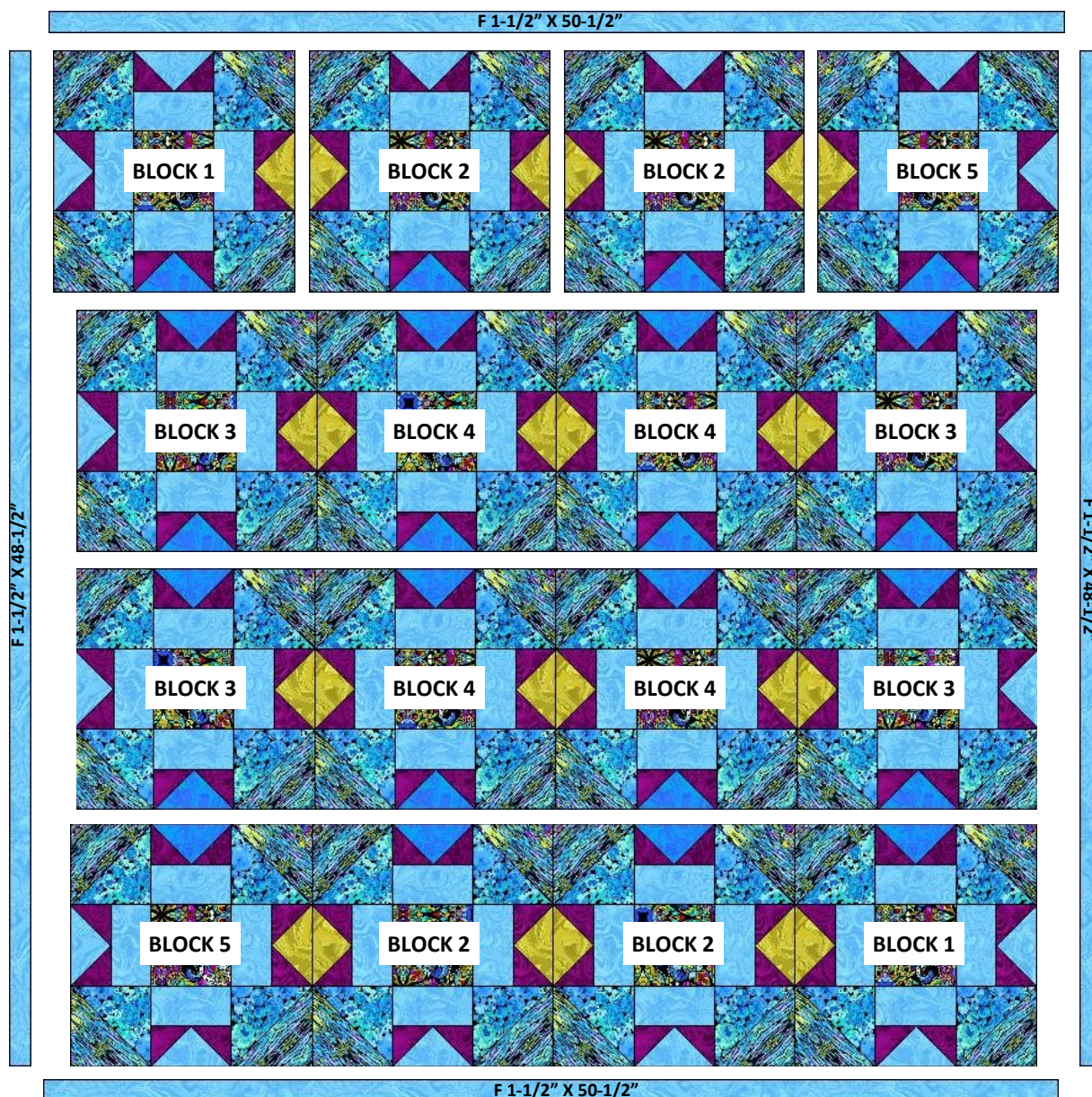
7. Sew blocks together into rows, then sew rows together.

BORDER ASSEMBLY: *Measure width and length of quilt top to ensure border cutting sizes. Below are our measurements*

8. Sew (1) F 1-1/2" X (48-1/2") strip to each side of quilt, then sew (1) F 1-1/2" X (50-1/2") strip to top and bottom of quilt.

QUILT DIAGRAM

SIZE: 50" x 50"



Note: If this Benartex pattern is included in a kit, any questions about the kit should be addressed to the vendor from whom you bought it.

FINISHING:

Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind with G fabric.
