Block Three rectangle. Sew (1) Block One square to each end of the newly sewn strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and the bottom of the Center Block.

BORDER ASSEMBLY MEASURE WIDTH AND LENGTH OF THE OUILT TOP TO ENSURE G, L AND M BORDER SIZES, BELOW ARE OUR CUTTING SIZES.
17. Sew (1) G 2-1/2" $x\left(66-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) G 2-1/2" x (70-1/2") strips to the top and bottom of Center Block.
18. Center (1) $\mathbf{L} 7-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} x(88$ ") strip on (1) side of the Center Block and pin in place. Start sewing the strip a $1 / 4$ " from the top edge of the block and stop 1/4" from the bottom edge. DO NOT TRIM THE EXCESS. Repeat with the opposite side.
19. Repeat Step 18 to sew (1) L $7-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times\left(88^{\prime \prime}\right)$ strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block, making sure to stop and start $1 / 4$ " away from each end of the block. To miter each corner, old the Center Block on a diagonal, wrong side together. This should line up the strips from adjacent sides.
20. Starting at the sewn seam (represented by the arrow in diagram below), draw a 45-degree line to the edge of the fabric. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the excess fabric leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam. Repeat this step with the remaining corners.

21. Sew (1) M $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} x\left(84-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) M 2-1/2" x (88-1/2") strips to the top and bottom of Center Block to make the quilt top.

FINISHING Cut batting and backing 3 " larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind as usual.

5. Place (1) E 6-7/8" square on top of (1) D 6-7/8" square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square. Sew $1 / 4$ " away from each side of the drawn diagonal line. Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the halfsquare triangles to measure 6-1/2" square to make (2) Unit 2 squares. Repeat to make (24) Unit 2 squares total.

6. Sew (1) F $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square to the left side of (1) G 3-1/2" square to make the top row. Sew (1) G 3-1/2" square to left side of (1) F 3-1/2 square to make the bottom row. Sew the (2) rows together to make (1) Unit 3 square. Repeat to make (24) Unit 3 squares total
7. Sew (1) Unit 2 square to the left side of (1) Unit 3 square to make the top row. Sew (1) Unit 3 square to the left side of (1) Unit 2 square to make the bottom row. Sew the (2) rows together to make (1) Block Two square. Repeat to make (12) Block Two squares total

8. Place (1) B 6-1/2" square on the top left corner of (1) $\mathbf{K} 12-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 18-1 / 2$ rectangle, right sides together. Sew across the diagonal of the small square from the upper right corner to the lower eft corner. Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle $1 / 4$ " away from the sewn seam

9. Follow the diagram below for the seam direction to add a B 6-1/2" square to each of the remaining corners of the $\mathbf{K}$ rectangle to make (1) Block Three rectangle.

## 10. Repeat Steps 8-9 to make (4) Block Three

 rectangles total.
11. Sew (1) Block Two square to each side of (1) Block One square to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom
row. Sew (1) Block One square to each side of (1) A 12-1/2" square to make the middle row. Sew the (3) rows together to make the Center Block.


## QUILT ASSEMBLY

12. Sew (1) $\mathbf{H} 1-1 / 4$ " $\times 36-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) H 1-1/4" x 38 " strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
13. Sew (1) I $2^{\prime \prime} \times 38^{\prime \prime}$ strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) J 2" square to each end of (1) I 2" x $38^{\prime \prime}$ strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
14. Sew (1) H 1-1/4" $\times 41^{\prime \prime}$ strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) H 1-1/4" x 42-1/2" strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
15. Sew (1) Block Two square to the top and to the bottom of (1) Block Three rectangle. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew (1) strip to each side of the Center Block
