WOF = Width of fabric | LOF = Length of Fabric / *Sew strips via short ends, then subcut as indicated in pattern

## CUTTING DIAGRAM

Cut (3) G 13" squares diagonally from bottom left to top right to create G1 and G2 Half Square Triangles (HSTs). Cut remaining (3) G 13" squares diagonally from top left to bottom right to create G3 and G4 HSTs. Cut (4) C $13^{\prime \prime}$ squares diagonally from bottom left to top right to create (8) C1 HSTs. NOTE: You will have 2 extra G1 and 2 extra G3 HSTs.


BLOCK DIAGRAMS
BLOCK ASSEMBLY: Refer to BLOCK DIAGRAMS

1. BLOCKS 1 and 2: Sew (2) E 6-1/2" squares and (2) F 6-1/2" squares together as shown to create BLOCK 1. Square to 12-1/2", make (2). Repeat using (2) E 6-1/2" squares and (2) D 6-1/2" squares to create BLOCK 2. Square to 12-1/2", make (2).
2. 
3. BLOCKS 3A, 3B, 3C and 3D: Sew HSTs together as shown to create blocks. Square all to $12-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$, make number indicated in diagram.


QUILT ASSEMBLY: Refer to QUILT DIAGRAM for proper block placement and rotation.
4. Sew (2) B 1-1/2" $\times 15-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to sides of A $15-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 23-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle, then sew (2) B $5^{\prime \prime} \times 25-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to top and bottom. Trim to 24-1/2" $\times 24-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ with A rectangle centered to create QUILT CENTER.
5. Sew (1) BLOCK 3A and (1) BLOCK 3C together, sew to left side of QUILT CENTER. Repeat, sew to right side of quilt center.
6. Sew (1) BLOCK 1, (1) BLOCK 3A, (1) BLOCK 3C and (1) BLOCK 2 together, sew to top.
7. Sew (1) BLOCK 2, (1) BLOCK 3D, (1) BLOCK 3B and (1) BLOCK 1 together, sew to bottom.

BORDER ASSEMBLY: Measure width and length of quilt top to ensure border cutting sizes. Below are our measurements
8. Sew (1) H 6-1/2" $X\left(48-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ strip to top and bottom of quilt.
9. Sew (1) $J 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} X\left(60-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ strip to each side of quilt, then sew (1) $J 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} X\left(56-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ strip to top and bottom of quilt.

## SUFFRAGE QUILT DIAGRAM

 SIZE: 56" x 68"

## FINISHING:

Cut batting and backing $3^{\prime \prime}$ larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind with J fabric.
