## Block Assembly

## Twin Frame Block - (TFB)

1. Draw a line diagonally on wrong side of (2) B $21 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$ squares. Place $B$ squares on each end of (1) C $6^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ piece. Note direction of diagonal line - Bottom right to top left on both ends of $C$ piece. Sew on diagonal line, trim off triangle $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ from seam. Press B triangles back to make BC set. Make (60) BC sets.
2. Sew (1) BC set to left and right side of (1) D $6 ½{ }^{\prime \prime}$ square. Make (15) BCDBC sets.

(60) $B C$ sets

3. Sew (1) A $2 \frac{1}{2} /{ }^{\prime \prime}$ square to either end of (1) $B C$ set, press. Make (30) ABCA sets.

4. Sew (1) ABCA set to the top and bottom of (1) BCDBC set to make (1) Twins Frame Block- TFB Make (15) TFB blocks


## Subway Tile Frame - (STFB)

5. Sew (1) E 3" x WOF strip to (1) C 3" $x$ WOF strip at long sides to make (1) EC strip set. Make (4) EC strip sets. Sub-cut strip sets into (90) EC 1 3/4" sets.
6. Sew (2) EC sets together at one end,
 making sure to sew C to E , (see diagram). To make (1) Double EC set. Make (30) Double CE sets.

7. Sew (1) C $3^{\prime \prime}$ x $13 / 4$ " piece C to the E side of (1) EC set to make (1) CEC set. Make (15) CEC sets.

8. Sew (1) E $3^{\prime \prime}$ x $13 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ piece to the C strip of (1) CE set to make (1) ECE set. Make (15) ECE sets.
9. Sew (1) CEC set to the left side of (1) F Fussy cut 8" square. Sew (1) ECE to right side of same $F$ square.
Make (15) Center Sections.
10. Sew (1) Double

EC set to the top and bottom of Center Section, to make Subway Tiles Frame Block-STFB.
Make (15) STFB.


## QUILT ASSEMBLY:

Refer to quilt diagram for placement of blocks. Sew blocks together to make each row.
11. For odd rows sew (3) TFBs and (2) STFBs and (4) B $10 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ together alternately to make rows 1,3 , and 5 .
12. For even rows sew (3) STFBs and (2) TFBs and (4) B $10 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ together alternately to make rows 2,4 , and 6 .
13. Sew (2) B $21^{1 / 2}$ " x WOF strips together at short end, sew to the bottom of rows 1,2 , 3,4 , and 5 . Press and trim even with ends or rows.
14. Sew Rows together in order, with 1 at top and 6 at the bottom of quilt center.

## BORDERS:

## Border \#1

15. Sew (2) B $2^{1 ⁄ 2 \prime}$ " x WOF strips together at short ends. Sew to left and right side of quilt center. Press and trim even with quilt center.
16. Sew (2) B $21 / 2 "$ x WOF strips together at short ends. Sew to top of quilt center. Press and trim even with quilt sides. Sew (1) B $2 \frac{1}{2} /{ }^{\prime \prime}$ strip to remainder of B strip from the top and sew to bottom of quilt center. Press and trim even with quilt sides.

## Border \#2

17. Follow Step 15 using C $31 / 2$ " x WOF strips, sew to the sides of quilt center. Press and trim even with quilt center.
18. Follow Step 15 using C $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF strips, sew to the top and bottom of quilt center. Press and trim even with quilt center.

## FINISHING:

Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top and baste or pin. When quilting is completed trim excess batting and backing. Bind as usual.
