BLOCK ASSEMBLY: Refer to BLOCK DIAGRAMS

1. Sew (1) A QST to (1) C QST to create AC Units, make (64).
2. Sew (1) AC Unit to each side of B6-1/2" square with text tilted to right to create BLOCK 1. Square to 9 ", make (8). Repeat with text tilted to left to create BLOCK 2. Square to $9^{\prime \prime}$, make (8).

QUILT ASSEMBLY: Refer to QUILT DIAGRAM for proper block placement and rotation.
3. Sew blocks together into rows, then sew rows together.

BORDER ASSEMBLY: Measure width and length of quilt top to ensure border cutting sizes. Below are our measurements
4. Sew (1) A WOF $2^{\prime \prime} X\left(34-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ strip to each side of quilt, then sew (1) A LOF $2^{\prime \prime} X\left(37-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ strip to top and bottom of quilt.

## FINISHING:

Cut batting and backing 3 " larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind with A fabric.
