## BLOCK ASSEMBLY: Refer to BLOCK DIAGRAMS

## BLOCK DIAGRAMS

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of all $\mathbf{N} 3^{\prime \prime}$ squares.

2. Place $\mathbf{N}$ square, right sides together, on one side of (1) $\mathbf{R} 3^{\prime \prime} \times 5-$ $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal $\mathbf{N}$ corner triangle. Repeat with another $\mathbf{N} 3$ " square on opposite side of $\mathbf{R}$ strip to complete $\mathbf{R N}$ UNIT, make (8).
3. Sew (1) RN UNIT to each side of (1) D 5-1/2" square.
4. Sew (1) R $3^{\prime \prime}$ square to each side of (1) RN UNIT, then sew to top of block. Repeat for bottom to complete BLOCK 1. Square to 101/2", make (2).
5. Repeat steps 2-4 using pieces indicated to make remaining blocks. Square all to 10-1/2", make number indicated.


BORDER ASSEMBLY: Measure width and length of quilt top to ensure border cutting sizes. Below are our measurements. Refer to QUILT DIAGRAM for proper placement and rotation.
8. Sew together (1) each BLOCK 5, BLOCK 4, BLOCK 6, BLOCK 7 and (1) L 10-1/2" X 12-1/2" rectangle to create SIDE BORDER UNIT. Make (2), then sew to sides of quilt.
9. Sew together (1) each BLOCK 1, BLOCK 2, BLOCK 3, BLOCK 4 and (1) L 10-1/2" X 16-1/2" rectangle to create TOP/BOTTOM BORDER UNIT. Make (2), then sew to top and bottom of quilt.
10. Sew (1) $\boldsymbol{K} 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} X\left(72-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ strip to each side of quilt, then sew (1) $\boldsymbol{K} 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} X\left(60-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ strip to top and bottom of quilt.
11. Sew (1) J $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} X\left(76-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ strip to each side of quilt, then sew (1) J 3-1/2" $X\left(66-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ strip to top and bottom of quilt.

## FINISHING:

Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind with $\mathbf{R}$ fabric.
