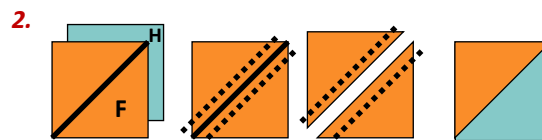
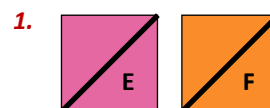
WOF = Width of fabric

	A AWESOME OWLS 9411-99 <i>White/Multi</i>	5/8 YD	(4) 4-1/2" X WOF strips, subcut (25) 4-1/2" squares		E HAPPY SWIRL 9416-26 <i>Pink</i>	1/4 YD	(1) 5" X WOF strip, subcut (8) 5" squares
	B AWESOME OWL STRIPE 9412-99 <i>Multi</i>	5/8 YD	(4) 1-1/2" X WOF strips, BORDER (6) 2-1/4" X WOF strips, BINDING		F HAPPY SWIRL 9416-28 <i>Orange</i>	3/8 YD	(2) 5" X WOF strip, subcut (12) 5" squares

BLOCK ASSEMBLY: Refer to **BLOCK DIAGRAMS**

1. Draw diagonal line on the wrong side of E and F squares.
2. Place (1) F 5" square right sides together with (1) H 5" square. Sew 1/4" on either side of diagonal line, then cut on drawn line. Press open and square to 4-1/2" to complete **BLOCK 1**, make (24).
3. Repeat Step 2 using E and G squares to create **BLOCK 2**. Square to 4-1/2", make (16).

QUILT ASSEMBLY: Refer to **QUILT DIAGRAM** for proper block placement and rotation.

4. Sew blocks and squares together into rows, then sew rows together.
 ROW 1: A - BLOCK 1 - C - BLOCK 2 - A - BLOCK 1 - C - BLOCK 1 - A
 ROW 2: BLOCK 1 - C - BLOCK 2 - A - BLOCK 1 - A - BLOCK 2 - C - BLOCK 1
 ROW 3: C - BLOCK 2 - A - BLOCK 1 - C - BLOCK 1 - A - BLOCK 2 - C
 ROW 4: BLOCK 1 - A - BLOCK 1 - C - BLOCK 2 - C - BLOCK 1 - A - BLOCK 2
 ROW 5: A - BLOCK 1 - C - BLOCK 2 - A - BLOCK 2 - C - BLOCK 1 - A
 ROW 6: BLOCK 2 - A - BLOCK 1 - C - BLOCK 2 - C - BLOCK 1 - A - BLOCK 1
 ROW 7: C - BLOCK 2 - A - BLOCK 1 - C - BLOCK 1 - A - BLOCK 2 - C
 ROW 8: BLOCK 1 - C - BLOCK 2 - A - BLOCK 1 - A - BLOCK 2 - C - BLOCK 1
 ROW 9: A - BLOCK 1 - C - BLOCK 1 - A - BLOCK 2 - C - BLOCK 1 - A

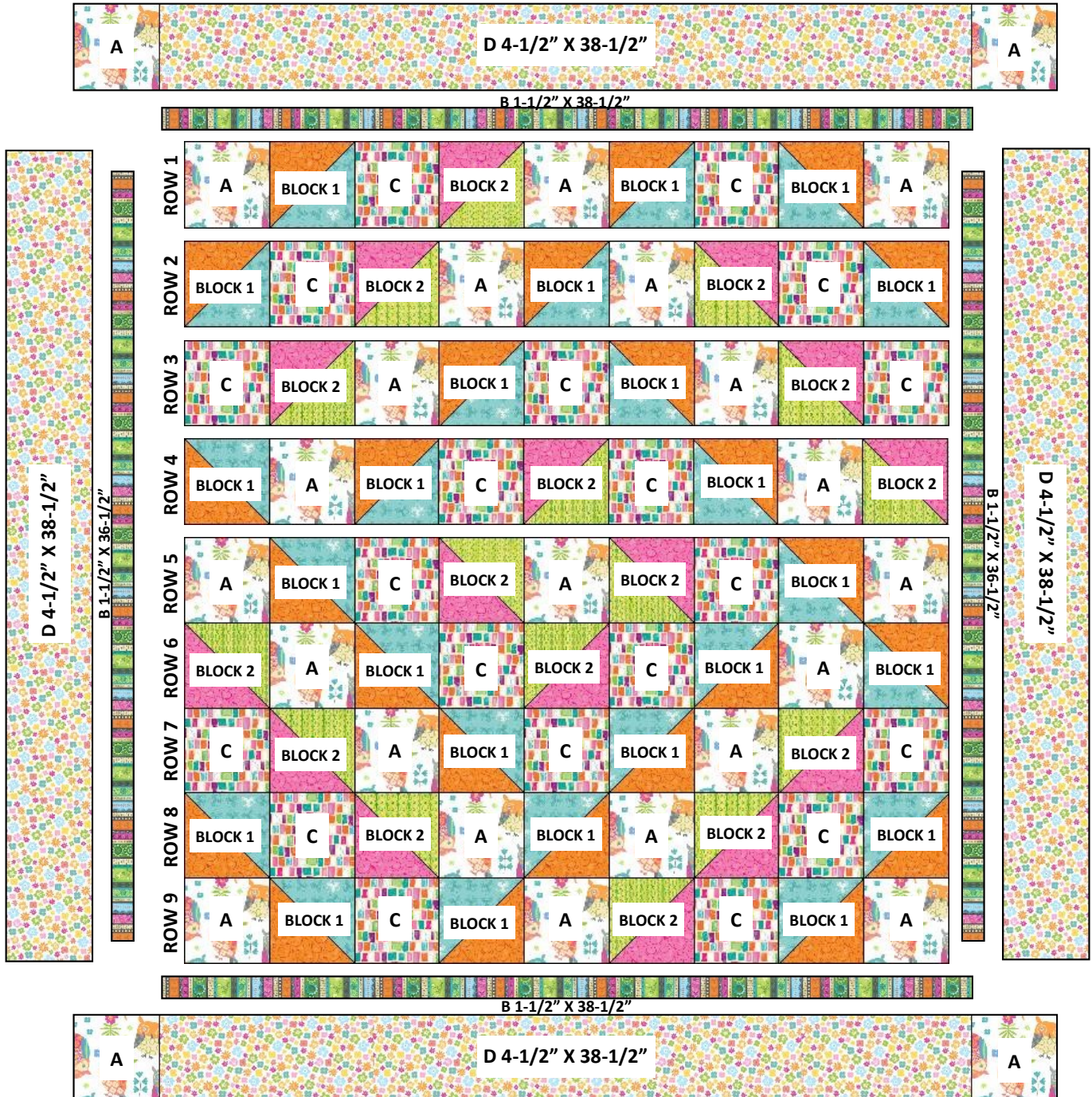
BORDER ASSEMBLY: Measure width and length of quilt top to ensure border cutting sizes. Below are *our measurements*.

5. Sew (1) B 1-1/2" X (36-1/2") strip to each side of quilt, then sew (1) B 1-1/2" X (38-1/2") strip to top and bottom.
6. Sew (1) D 4-1/2" X (38-1/2") strip to each side of quilt. Sew (1) A 4-1/2" square to each end of (1) D 4-1/2" X (38-1/2") strip. Make (2), then sew to top and bottom.

FINISHING:

Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind with B fabric.
