WOF = Width of fabric | LOF = Length of fabric | *Sew strips via short ends, then subcut as indicated in pattern

## BLOCK ASSEMBLY: Refer to BLOCK DIAGRAMS

1. BLOCK 1: Draw diagonal line on the wrong side of $\mathbf{D} 5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares. Place (1) D 5-1/2" square right sides together with (1) G $5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square. Sew $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ on either side of diagonal line, then cut on drawn line. Press open and square to $5^{\prime \prime}$ to complete BLOCK 1. Make (16).
2. BLOCK 2: Sew (2) BLOCK 1s together as shown to create BLOCK 2. Square to $5^{\prime \prime}$ X 9-1/2", make (6).
3. BLOCK 3: Sew (1) D 3-1/4" X 9-1/2" rectangle and (1) H 2-1/4" X $9-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip together to create BLOCK 3. Square to $5^{\prime \prime} \times 9-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$, make (10).
4. BLOCK 4: Sew (1) H $2-1 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 9-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ to each side of (1) E $6^{\prime \prime} X$ $9-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles to create BLOCK 4. Square to $9-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$, make (7).

QUILT ASSEMBLY: Refer to QUILT DIAGRAM for proper block placement and rotation.

5. Sew blocks together into rows, then sew rows together.

ROWS 1 \& 7: BLOCK 1 - BLOCK 3 - BLOCK 2 - BLOCK 3 - BLOCK 1

ROWS 2, 4 \& 6: BLOCK 3 - A 9-1/2" square - BLOCK 4 - A 9-1/2" square - BLOCK 3
ROWS 3 \& 5: BLOCK 2 - BLOCK 4 - C 9-1/2" square - BLOCK 4 - BLOCK 2
BORDER ASSEMBLY: Measure width and length of quilt top to ensure border cutting sizes. Below are our measurements
6. Sew (1) D 2-1/2" $X\left(54-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ strip to each side of quilt, then sew (1) D 2-1/2" $X$ ( $40-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ ) strip to top and bottom of quilt.
7. Sew (1) G $2-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} X\left(58-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ strip to top of (1) B $4^{\prime \prime} \times 58-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ LOF strip to create SIDE BORDER UNIT. Make (2), then sew to sides of quilt.
8. Sew (1) G 2-3/4" X (40-1/2") strip to top of (1) B $4^{\prime \prime}$ X 40-1/2" LOF strip, then sew (1) H 5-1/2" square to each end to create TOP BORDER UNIT. Sew to top of quilt.
9. Sew (1) G 2-3/4" X (40-1/2") strip to bottom of (1) B $4^{\prime \prime} \times 40-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ LOF strip then sew (1) H 5-1/2" square to each end to create BOTTOM BORDER UNIT. Sew to bottom of quilt.

## FINISHING:

Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind with $\mathbf{F}$ fabric.
