## CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

WOF $=$ Width of fabric *Sew strips via short ends, then subcut as indicated in pattern


CUTTING NOTES:

- We recommend using spray starch or sizing on your fabrics prior to cutting to minimize bias edge stretching.
- Place templates right side up on WRONG side of fabric strips when cutting.
- Fabrics B and C - Cut (4) of Template \#3 from each strip - keep marked side on same edge of strip.
- Fabric D - Cut (5) of Template \#2 from each strip - keep marked side on same edge of strip.
- Fabric F - Cut (7) of Template \#4 from each strip - keep marked side on same edge of strip.
- Fabrics $\mathbf{E}$ and $\mathbf{G}$ - Cut (6) of Template \#1 from each strip - keep marked side on same edge of strip.


## BLOCK ASSEMBLY: Refer to BLOCK DIAGRAMS

BLOCK DIAGRAMS

Note: Press all seams open.

1. Sew (1) F triangle to (1) $\mathbf{D}$ triangle to create FD UNIT. Make (80).
2. Sew (1) G triangle and (1) B triangle to FD UNIT to create UNIT 1. Make (40).
3. Sew (1) E triangle and (1) C triangle to FD UNIT to create UNIT 2. Make (40).
4. Sew (2) UNIT 1s and (2) UNIT 2 s together to create BLOCK. Square to 12-1/2", make (20).

QUILT ASSEMBLY: Refer to QUILT DIAGRAM
5. Sew BLOCKS together into rows, then sew rows together.

## BORDER ASSEMBLY: Refer to QUILT DIAGRAM

Measure width and length of quilt top to ensure border cutting sizes. Below are our measurements
6. Sew (1) A 3-1/2" $X\left(60-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ strip to each side of quilt, then sew
(1) A 3-1/2" X (54-1/2") strip to top and bottom.

FINISHING:
Cut batting and backing 3 " larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind with $\mathbf{G}$ fabric.
