[^1]BLOCK ASSEMBLY PROJECT USES PRECISE 1/4" SEAMS. TEST YOUR SEAM ALLOWANCE BY CUTTING (2) 2-1/2" X 5" RECTANGLES. STITCH THEM TOGETHER ALONG THE 5" LENGTH. AT THE MIDPOINT, MEASURE ACROSS THE UNIT. IT SHOULD BE EXACTLY 4-1/2" WIDE. IF NOT, ADJUST YOUR SEAM ALLOWANCE AND REPEAT.

## Block Assembly

The arrows in the diagrams represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations while assembling the various components.

1. Place (1) F 3-1/2" square on the left side of (1) E $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip, right sides together. Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner. Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance.

2. Place another $\mathbf{F} 3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square on the right side of the E 3-1/2" x 10-1/2" strip, right sides together. Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner. Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance to make (1) Unit 1 strip.
3. Repeat Steps 1-2 to make (12) Unit $\mathbf{1}$ strips total.

4. Repeat Steps 1-2 and refer to the diagram below for fabric identification, placement, seam direction and orientation to make (24) Unit 2 strips.

5. Sew (1) G $3-1 / 2$ " square to each side of (1) E $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to make (1) Unit 3 strip. Repeat to make (4) Unit 3 strips total.

6. Sew (1) G 3-1/2" square to the top and to the bottom of (1) E 3-1/2" x 4-1/2" strip to make (1) Unit 4 strip. Repeat to make (4) Unit 4 strips total.
7. Sew (1) D 3-1/2" square to each side of (1) B 3-1/2" x $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) C 3-1/2" x $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to each side of (1) A 4-1/2" square to make the middle row. Sew together the (3) rows lengthwise to make
(1) 10-1/2" Block One square.

Repeat to make (13) Block One squares total.
8. Sew (1) A $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to each side of (1) $\mathbf{H}$ 4-1/2" square. Sew (1) Unit 2 strip to the top and to the bottom of the newly sewn strip lengthwise to make (1) 10-1/2" Block Two square. Repeat to make (12) Block Two squares total.

9. Sew together (1) G 3-1/2" square, (1) Unit 1 strip,
(1) Unit 3 strip, (1) Unit 1 strip, (1) Unit 3 strip,
(1) Unit 1 strip and (1) G 3-1/2" square, in that order from left to right, to make Row One.
10. Repeat Step 9 and refer to the Center Block diagram for component identification, placement and orientation to make Row Two through Row Seven.
11. Sew together the (7) Rows, lengthwise and in numerical order from top to bottom, to make the Center Block.

BORDER ASSEMBLY MEASURE WIDTH AND LENGTH OF THE QUILT TOP TO ENSURE D AND I BORDER SIZES, BELOW ARE OUR CUTTING SIZES.
12. Sew (1) D $2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}\left(56-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) D 2" x (59-1/2") strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
13. Sew (1) I 5 " $x\left(59-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ strip to each side of the

Center Block. Sew (1) H 5" square to each end of (1) I 5" x (59-1/2") strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

FINISHING Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind as usual.
