
Block Assembly:

- 1. Draw a diagonal line on the back of all 1-1/2" tan squares.
- 2. Lay one on the right side of a 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" blue strip with right sides together (RST) and sew the drawn line. See A.
- 3. Press the seam open and trim the excess fabric on back.
- 4 See B
- 5. Make 4 like this plus 4 more in reverse for the petals.
- 6. See C.
- 7. Draw a diagonal line on the back of four 2" blue squares.
- 8. Lay one on the corner of a 6~1/2" gold square and sew the line. See D.
- 9. Press the seam open and trim the excess fabric on back.
- 10. See E.
- 11. Sew two blue strips (B/C) together for each side of the flower. See F.
- 12. Sew one set down both sides of the center 6-1/2" gold square. See G.
- 13. Sew a 2~1/2" background colored square to the right side of the remaining two blue strips. See H below.
- 14. Sew one 2-1/2" green square to the left side of each.
- 15. See I.
- 16. Sew these strips across the top and bottom (flipped) of the block. See J below.
- 17. Sew one 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" green strip to each 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" tan strip.
- 18. Sew one down each side. See K below.
- 19. Draw a diagonal line on the back of two 2-1/2" tan squares.
- 20. Lay one on the end of both 2~1/2" x 4~1/2" green strips with (RST) and sew both drawn lines in the directions shown below. See L.
- 21. Press both seams open and trim the excess fabric.
- 22. Make 3 more flower blocks exactly the same way then make 3 with dark green leaves in reverse.


Finishing~

- 1. Lay out the blocks into three columns.
- 2. The blocks with dark green leaves have a * in the center.
- 3. Sew a 2 1/2" x 14 1/2" background strip down each side of three blocks noted with a \Diamond .
- 4. Turn the blocks as shown.
- 5. Insert the 7-1/2" x 14-1/2" tan background strips into each column A & C using the diagram.
- 6. Insert the 4-1/2" x 14-1/2" tan background strips then sew each column and press the seams.
- 7. Sew all three columns together.
- 8. Sew the 2-1/2" x LOF background strips down each side and trim off the excess fabric.
- 9. Sew the 2~1/2" x LOF background strips across the top and bottom and trim off the excess fabric.
- 10. Sew the 4-1/2" x LOF border strips down each side and trim off the excess fabric.
- 11. Sew the 4~1/2" x LOF border strips across the top and bottom and trim off the excess fabric.

Quilting~

- 1. Cut the 3-1/8 yd backing fabric in half and sew the 56-1/4" lengths together.
- 2. Lay the quilt top on a layer of batting and your backing fabric.
- 3. Quilt by hand or machine.
- 4. Sew the four binding strips end to end making one continuous strip of binding.
- 5. Fold in half lengthwise with right sides out and press flat.
- 6. Pin the binding along the quilt with the raw edge toward the outside edge.
- 7. Sew the binding in place.



- 8. Miter each corner as shown and overlap the ends by at least 1/2".
- 9. Fold over to the back and pin in place.
- 10. Hand-stitch on the back of the quilt.
