## CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

WOF = Width of fabric | HST = Half Square Triangle \| *Sew strips via short ends, then subcut as indicated in pattern

## BLOCK ASSEMBLY: Refer to BLOCK DIAGRAMS

1. Draw diagonal line on the wrong side of $\mathbf{A}, \mathbf{B}, \mathbf{D}, \mathbf{E}, \mathbf{G}, \mathbf{J}$ and $\mathbf{L} 4^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
2. Place(1) B 4" square right sides together with (1) D 4" square. Sew $1 / 4$ " on either side of diagonal line, then cut on drawn line. Press open and square to $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$. Make (16).
3. Repeat Step 2 to create all HST UNITS, square all to $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$, make number indicated.
4. Sew the indicated HST UNITS together into rows, pressing seam allowances in the direction of arrows. Sew rows together to create BLOCK 1. Square to 12-1/2", make (8).
5. Sew the indicated HST UNITS together into rows, pressing seam allowances in the direction of arrows. Sew rows together to create BLOCK 2. Square to 12-1/2", make (8).

NOTE: For Steps 4 \& 5 - be sure to refer to IMAGES BELOW for proper rotation of HST UNITS.

## BLOCK DIAGRAMS



QUILT ASSEMBLY: Refer to QUILT DIAGRAM for proper block placement and rotation.
6. Sew blocks and $\mathbf{M}$ 1-1/2" $\times 12-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips together into rows, then sew rows and (3) M 1-1/2" $\times 51-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ sashing strips together. ROWS 1 \& 3: BLOCK 1 - M STRIP - BLOCK 2 - M STRIP - BLOCK 1 - M STRIP - BLOCK 2 ROWS 2 \& 4: BLOCK 2 - M STRIP - BLOCK 1 - M STRIP - BLOCK 2 - M STRIP - BLOCK 1

BORDER ASSEMBLY: Measure width and length of quilt top to ensure border cutting sizes. Below are our measurements
7. Sew (1) $\mathbf{M} 1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} X\left(51-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ strip to each side of quilt, then sew (1) $\mathbf{M} 1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} X\left(53-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ strip to top and bottom of quilt.

FINISHING:
Cut batting and backing $3^{\prime \prime}$ larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind with $\mathbf{M}$ fabric.
