## UNIT ASSEMBLY: Refer to BLOCK DIAGRAMS

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of all $\mathbf{D}, \mathbf{E}$, and $\mathbf{G} 2-1 / \mathbf{2}^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
2. Place $\mathbf{D}$ square, right sides together, on one side of (1) $\boldsymbol{J} 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} x$ $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal D corner triangle. Repeat with another D 2-1/2" square on opposite side of J strip to complete DJ UNIT, make (16).
3. Repeat step 2 using $\mathbf{E}$ squares and $J$ rectangles to make (16) EJ UNITs and G squares and J rectangles to make (24) GJ UNITs.

## BLOCK ASSEMBLY:

4. Sew (1) DJ UNIT to each side of (1) A 4-1/2" square.
5. Sew (1) J 2-1/2" square to each side of (1) DJ UNIT, then sew to top of block. Repeat for bottom to complete BLOCK 1A. Square to 8-1/2", make (2).
6. Repeat steps 4 and 5 using pieces indicated to make remaining blocks. Square all to 8-1/2", make number indicated on next page.

QUILT ASSEMBLY: Refer to QUILT DIAGRAM for proper placement and rotation.
7. Cut (1) $\mathbf{F} 1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 32-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip from pieced $\mathbf{F} 1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips, then sew to each side of $\mathbf{A}$ Panel.
8. Sew (1) BLOCK 2A, (1) BLOCK 2B and (2) BLOCK 2Cs together, then sew to left side of quilt. Repeat on right side.
9. Measure top and bottom of quilt and cut (2) F 1-1/2" pieces to fit (ours is $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} X 40-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ ), then sew $F$ strips to top and bottom.
10. Sew (1) BLOCK 1A, (1) BLOCK 1B, (1) BLOCK 1C, and (2) B 8-1/2" squares together, then sew to top quilt. Repeat on bottom.

BORDER ASSEMBLY: Measure width and length of quilt top to ensure border cutting sizes. Below are our measurements. Refer to QUILT DIAGRAM for proper placement and rotation.
11. Sew (1) F 1-1/2" $X\left(50-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ strip to each side of quilt, then sew (1) F 1-1/2" $X\left(42-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ strip to top and bottom of quilt.
12. Sew (1) H 4-1/2" $X\left(52-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ strip to each side of quilt, then sew (1) H 4-1/2" $X\left(50-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ strip to top and bottom of quilt.

FINISHING:
Cut batting and backing $3^{\prime \prime}$ larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind with $\mathbf{F}$ fabric.
