

# Autumn Glow

48" x 60"



Make 18 blocks plus 4 half blocks

You need  $\frac{3}{4}$  yards of #9618F-07 Cream

For the center of each star:

Cut 18 6-1/2" squares

Plus

Cut 4 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" strips

You need  $1\frac{2}{3}$  yards of #9618F-71 Camel

For the points on each star:

Cut 160 3-1/2" squares

1/2 yards of Binding #9618F-73 Caramel:

Cut 6 2-1/4" x WOF strips

1/8 yard each of 20 colors for the backgrounds

Then cut from each of 18 background colors:

Cut 4 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" strips

4 3-1/2" squares

And from two background colors (Rows 2 & 4):

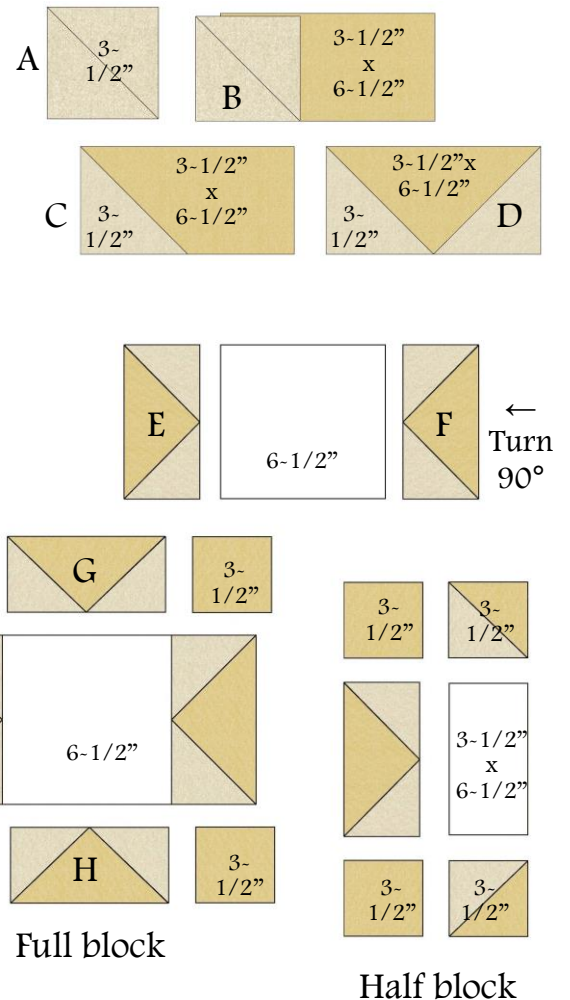
Cut 2 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" strips

8 3-1/2" squares

Backing fabric 3 yards

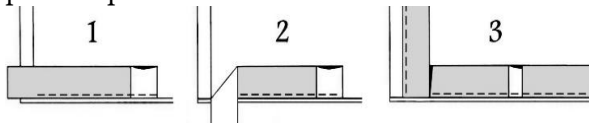
## Block Assembly-

1. Draw a diagonal line on the back of a 3-1/2" camel square to be used for the points. See A.
2. Lay it on one side of the background colored 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" strip with right sides together (RST) and sew the line. See B.
3. Flip the triangle back and press the seam open. See C.
4. Repeat with another 3-1/2" square on the other side of the same strip. See D.
5. Trim off the excess fabric on back.
6. Repeat the process for all 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" background strips.
7. Turn two of them 90°. See E.
8. Sew one strip to each side of center 6-1/2" square. See F.
9. Sew a 3-1/2" background colored square to each end of the remaining top and bottom row 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" strips. See G and H.
10. Line up and sew the block together.
11. Make 18 blocks the same way.
12. Make four half blocks with the last two background colors:  
Use only one 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" side strip with the directions above and make two HSTs for the top and bottom.  
The cream center is 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" also.
13. Lay out the blocks into five rows then sew each row across.
14. Sew the 6-1/2" x 12-1/2" half blocks to each end of Rows 2 and 4.
15. Sew the five rows together.



## Finishing-

1. Lay the quilt top on a layer of batting and backing fabric.
2. Hand or machine the quilt.
3. Sew the binding strips end to end, making a continuous strip of binding.
4. Fold in half lengthwise, with right sides out, and press flat.
5. Pin the binding around the edge of the pieced top with the raw edges to the outside edge of the quilt.
6. Sew the binding face down to the top of the pieced quilt.



7. Miter each corner as shown and overlap the ends.
8. Fold over to the back and pin in place.
9. Hand-stitch on the back of the quilt.
